The U. S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) today announced the publication of a research report entitled "Para-Transit: Neglected Options for Urban Mobility." The study was prepared by the Urban Institute under the sponsorship of the UMTA Office of Research and Development.

The report investigates urban transportation modes referred to collectively as "para-transit," including daily and short-term rental cars, taxi, dial-a-ride, jitney, carpool, and subscription bus service. The report makes a current, detailed review of experience with para-transit. Also, it assesses the potential roles of these services in urban transportation systems. Recommendations are made for overcoming obstacles to worthwhile applications of para-transit modes.
