The U. S. Department of Transportation Broadcast News Service for Monday, August 6, has a story on graduate study fellowships in highway safety.

"The Federal Highway Administration has awarded 48 fellowships worth five thousand dollars each for full time graduate study in highway safety and traffic engineering during the coming academic year. The objective of the program is to assist State and local agencies in developing the export manpower needed for the implementation of their highway safety programs. The fellowship winners represent 22 states and will attend 26 universities, and include State, city and county agency employees and students. They were permitted to select their own universities provided that the required safety and traffic courses are available."
