Secretary of Transportation Claude S. Brinegar today announced the appointment of Mrs. Juanita Greene of Florida to the Citizens' Advisory Committee on Transportation Quality.

The 21 member committee evaluates Departmental programs, recommends transportation initiatives and acts as a citizens' sounding board.

"The Department recognizes the need for obtaining the views and advice of the private citizen," Secretary Brinegar said. "I welcome Mrs. Greene, who brings to her new role of representing the transportation consumer, a wealth of community experience."

The Citizens' Advisory Committee reports its findings to the Secretary through the Assistant Secretary for Environment, Safety and Consumer Affairs. Its members serve a maximum term of three years.

Mrs. Greene, a native of Louisiana, received her B.A. degree in journalism from Louisiana State University. She is presently a feature writer and member of the Editorial Board of the Miami Herald.

Mrs. Greene is a member of the Dade County Commission on the Status of Women, the Steering Committee of the Mental Health Consortium of the Health Planning Council, and founder and Director of the League of Working Mothers. She is also a member and official reporter of the S.E. Regional American Assembly on The Future of Urban Transportation.
