The U.S. Department of Transportation Broadcast News Service for Monday, September 30 has a story by a Department spokeswoman on a safety award.

"The Federal Aviation Administration has announced the U.S. Air Force Aero Clubs to receive the Annual Flight Safety Award for completing a full year of flight operations without a single aircraft accident. Thirty-three of the flying clubs will receive the award for 1972 operations, including the Bergstrom Air Force Base Aero Club of Austin, Texas, receiving its seventh consecutive award for achieving an accident-free year. Aero Club members, consisting of officers and enlisted men, flew almost 241,000 flight hours during 1972."
