The U.S. Department of Transportation Broadcast News Service for Thursday, September 20, has a story on airport certification.

"The Federal Aviation Administration has proposed that the frequency of operations be used to determine if airports receiving air carrier service on an irregular basis must have FAA operating certificates. Airports regularly serving airlines must be certified as meeting FAA safety standards. The FAA also extended the deadline for the airports serving the air carriers on an irregular basis to obtain provisional operating certificates from October 5 to December 15."

This advisory for broadcasters, excerpts from a speech on highway planning and mass transit today by Federal Highway Administrator Norbert Tiemann will be available after 12:15 EDT.
