A \$4,091,000 planning grant to the Tri-State Regional Planning Commission, New York, New York, was announced today by the U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA).

The Tri-State Regional Planning Commission is the official regional planning agency in the New York, New Jersey and Connecticut metropolitan area.

The grant is designed to help the commission coordinate comprehensive land use and transportation plans for ten local sponsors in the 8000 square mile area. Eighty technical study projects ranging from a study of Second Avenue Subway connections to a disadvantaged mass transit users study are included in the project.

The Tri-State Regional Planning Commission is providing the local one-fifth share of the total project cost.
