## URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION

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During August 1976 the U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) announced the award of 58 grants totaling \$53,610,499.

A digest of the announced grants including a short description of capital improvement and research projects, their dollar amount, UMTA project number and date of announcement follows. Transit planning (technical studies), Section 5 apportioned funds (operating assistance), managerial training and university research and training grants are so noted.
