U. S. Secretary of Transportation William T. Coleman Jr., today announced the approval of 84 grants totaling \$98,695,407.

The approvals made by the Department's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA), are to cities throughout the nation for both local operating assistance and transit equipment requirements.

The projects were approved under Section 5 provisions of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964 as amended.

The Federal funds will be made available to these communities upon completion of UMTA contractual requirements.
