The U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass

Transportation Administration (UMTA) has published the

third in a series of <u>Urban Mass Transportation Abstracts</u>, a

general reference index to reports generated under contract

to UMTA. This volume includes brief descriptions of 298

reports, including technical studies; research, development

and demonstration project reports; and university research

and training reports.

The reports document studies ranging from transit feasibility studies for specific localities, economic cost analyses of mass transit programs and mobility projects for elderly and handicapped persons to a wide range of technical developments, including automatic fare collection systems, automated vehicle monitoring systems, techniques of noise abatement for transit, and advanced bus and rail propulsion systems. Complete indices to the volume by report title, personal and corporate author, geographic location and keywords are included.
