During March 1977, the U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) announced the award of 58 grants totaling \$64,137,805.

A digest of the announced grants, including a short description of capital improvement and research projects, their dollar amount, UMTA project number and date of announcement, follows. Transit planning (technical studies), Section 5 apportioned funds for operating assistance, managerial training and university research and training grants are so noted.
