DOT AWARDS \$29 MILLION FOR
DETROIT OPERATING SUBSIDY

Secretary of Transportation Brock Adams announced today a \$29,433,760 grant to assist in meeting transit operating expenses of the Southeastern Michigan Transportation Authority (SEMTA).

"The grant, for SEMTA operating expenses, will help improve and continue mass transportation service in the Detroit metropolitan area", Secretary Adams noted.

The eligible operating expenses are covered for service provided commuters in the Detroit urbanized area from July 1, 1977 through June 30, 1978.
