DOT PUBLISHES ABSTRACTS
OF UNIVERSITY TRANSIT RESEARCH

Abstracts of 285 reports from recent government-supported transportation research projects are contained in a booklet released by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

The research projects, conducted by universities, were supported by the University Research and Training Grant Program under DOT's Urban Mass Transportation Administration.

The book, "Abstracts for University Research Projects," serves as a reference document for urban transportation researchers, planners, operators, and those in the academic community who deal with transportation issues. The abstracts are divided into 30 transportation-related categories which include cost studies, elderly and handicapped, energy and environment, goods movement, labor relations, paratransit and many more.

UMTA's University Research and Training Grant Program began in 1970 and was authorized by Section 11 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended in that year. Grants are intended "...to assist in establishing or carrying on comprehensive research in the problems of transportation in urban areas...to conduct competent and qualified research and investigations into the theoretical or practical problems of urban transportation ...(and) to provide for the training of persons to carry on further research or to obtain employment in private or public organizations which plan, construct, operate or manage urban transportation systems."
