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UMTA GRANTS TOTALED \$356 MILLION IN AUGUST UMTA 78-63

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During August 1978, the U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) announced the award of 129 grants totaling \$356,193,532.

A digest of the announced grants, including a short description of capital improvement and research projects, their dollar amount, UMTA project number and date of announcement, follows. Transit planning (technical studies), Section 5 apportioned funds for operating assistance, managerial training and university research and training grants are so noted.
