The United States Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) today announced the award of \$131,387 to the New York State Department of Transportation to assist in transportation planning in the Albany area. The study will support the Unified Work Program for continuing transportation planning in the Capital District.

Frank C. Herringer, UMTA Administrator noted that the study funds will be used for updating the Capital District Transportation Study files being used as a data base for area planning.

The study also will provide needed planning data and technical assistance to area jurisdictions responsible for land development and transportation projects. In addition, a 1990 Regional Transportation Plan and Continuing Study Design will be prepared.

The local one-fifth share of the project cost is being provided by the New York State Department of Transportation.
