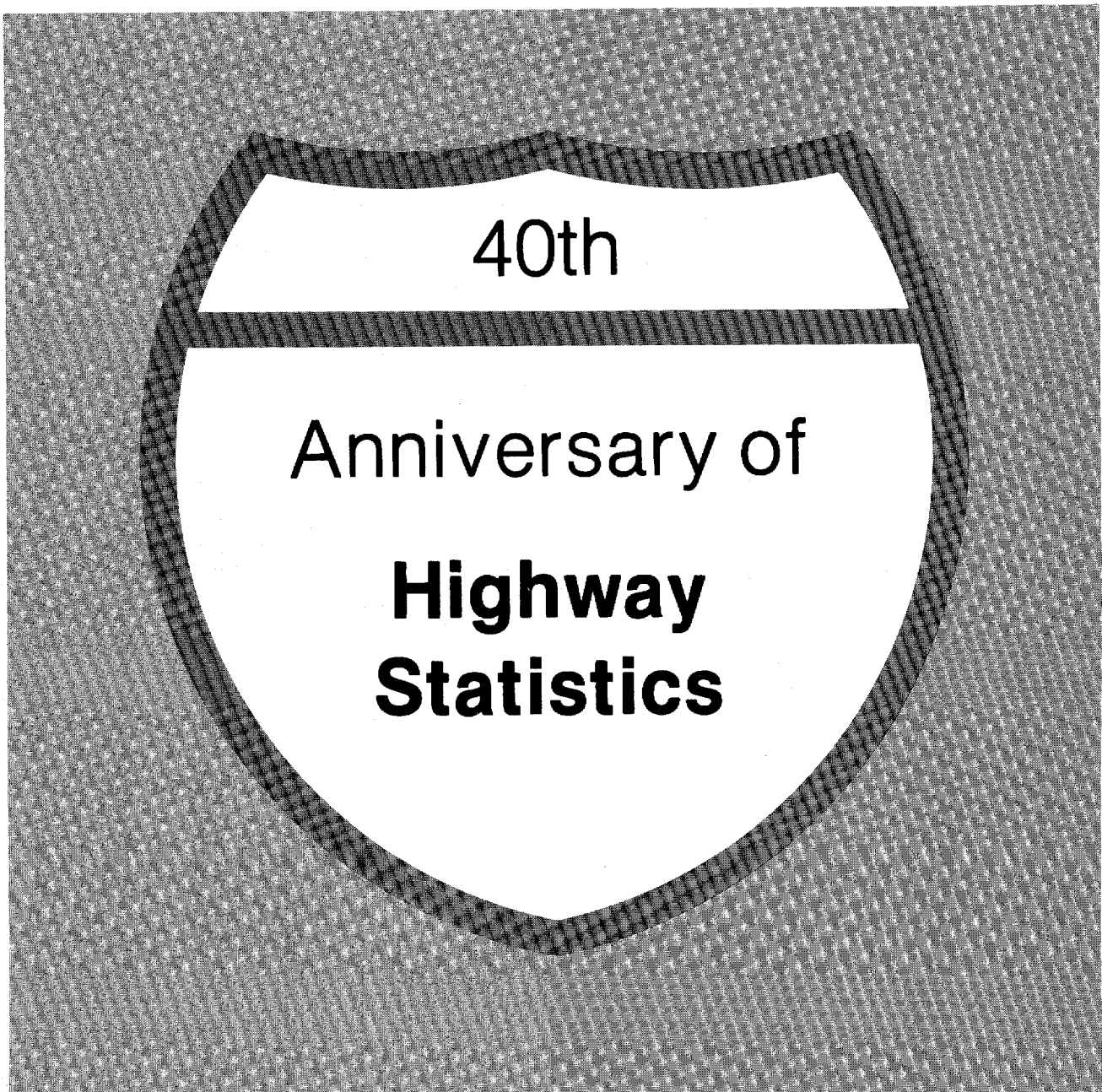

SELECTED HIGHWAY STATISTICS & CHARTS -- 1985

MOTOR FUEL - Highway Use of Gasoline up 2.2 Percent; Special Fuels (Diesel) Use up 2.8 Percent

Highway use of motor fuel in 1985 totaled 121.4 billion gallons, an increase of 2.3 percent from 1984. In 1986, highway use of motor fuel is expected to increase by about 3.7 percent. Motor-fuel revenues increased 6.4 percent from 1984, reflecting a number of tax increases which occurred in 1984 and 1985. Motor-fuel revenues are expected to increase by about 12.6 percent in 1986, reflecting additional rate increases in 1986 and the continuing influence of those which took effect during 1985.

The increase in motor-fuel usage reflects a continued growth in travel and occurred despite an increase in the fuel efficiency of the vehicle fleet from 14.47 MPG in 1984 to 14.62 in 1985.

MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS - Total Motor-Vehicle Registrations Exceed 170 Million in 1985

Motor-vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 166,248,816 in 1984 to 171,690,733 in 1985, an increase of 3.3 percent. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues increased 12.2 percent primarily due to increases in fees. Motor-vehicle registrations for 1986 are expected to exceed 1985 by 2.8 percent for a total of 176,532,000. Motor-vehicle and motor-carrier revenues are expected to increase by 4.8 percent in 1986.

DRIVER LICENSING - Number of Licensed Drivers up 1 Percent

The total of 156.9 million licensed drivers in 1985 reflects an increase of 1 percent over 1984. The number of female drivers is growing considerably faster than the number of male drivers--1.2 percent versus 0.7 percent. Total drivers for 1986 are expected to be 1.1 percent higher than in 1985.

HIGHWAY FINANCE - Highway Receipts Increased by \$5 billion; Highway Capital Outlay Increased by 16 Percent

Highway-user imposts, consisting of motor-fuel taxes, motor-vehicle taxes and fees, and highway tolls, increased by \$2.3 billion from 1984 to 1985. These revenues, totaling \$35.6 billion, accounted for 59.5 percent of the total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1985. Total receipts were slightly less than \$60 billion, an increase of 9.6 percent over 1984. Receipts from nonuser sources--that is, general revenues, property taxes, investment income and miscellaneous receipts--totaling \$18.9 billion, recorded a slight increase from 1984. However, highway bond proceeds amounted to \$5.3 billion for 1985, an increase of \$2 billion or 67 percent from 1984.

Total highway expenditures amounted to \$56.9 billion in 1985, up \$6.2 billion from 1984. Capital outlay increased by \$3.7 billion, or 16.3 percent, to \$26.8 billion. However, due to inflation in highway construction prices, the real increase in highway investments was only 4.7 percent. Highway maintenance and traffic service expenditures amounted to \$16 billion, an increase of \$1 billion or 6.9 percent. However, inflation accounted for nearly all of the increase as real expenditures increased by less than 1 percent over 1984.

Total receipts for highways by all units of government exceeded expenditures by \$3 billion in 1985, down \$1 billion from the \$4 billion in 1984, resulting in a total increase in reserves of \$7 billion for the years 1984 and 1985. These funds are expected to be reflected in significantly increased expenditures (notably capital outlay) in 1986 and beyond.

For the 50 States and D.C., highway-user imposts accounted for 75 percent of the \$30.9 billion in State highway receipts for 1985. State highway receipts from user fees increased by \$2 billion in 1985; whereas nonuser sources increased by \$658 million and accounted for about 14 percent of State receipts. The greatest increase was in bond proceeds--\$3.4 billion--or nearly double the 1984 amount. Bond proceeds exclude refunding issues. State highway programs reached nearly \$35 billion (excluding grants-in-aid to local governments) in 1985, an increase of \$5 billion, or 16.7 percent, over 1984. Highway capital outlay (\$20 billion) continues to account for an increasing share of total expenditures--58.2 percent--a gain of 1.5 percent from 1984.

ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL - Travel up 3.3 Percent

Existing public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1985, totaled approximately 3.86 million miles, a decrease of 0.8 percent from 1984.

Highway travel in the United States increased to an estimated 1,775 billion vehicle miles in 1985--an increase of about 3.3 percent from the previous year.

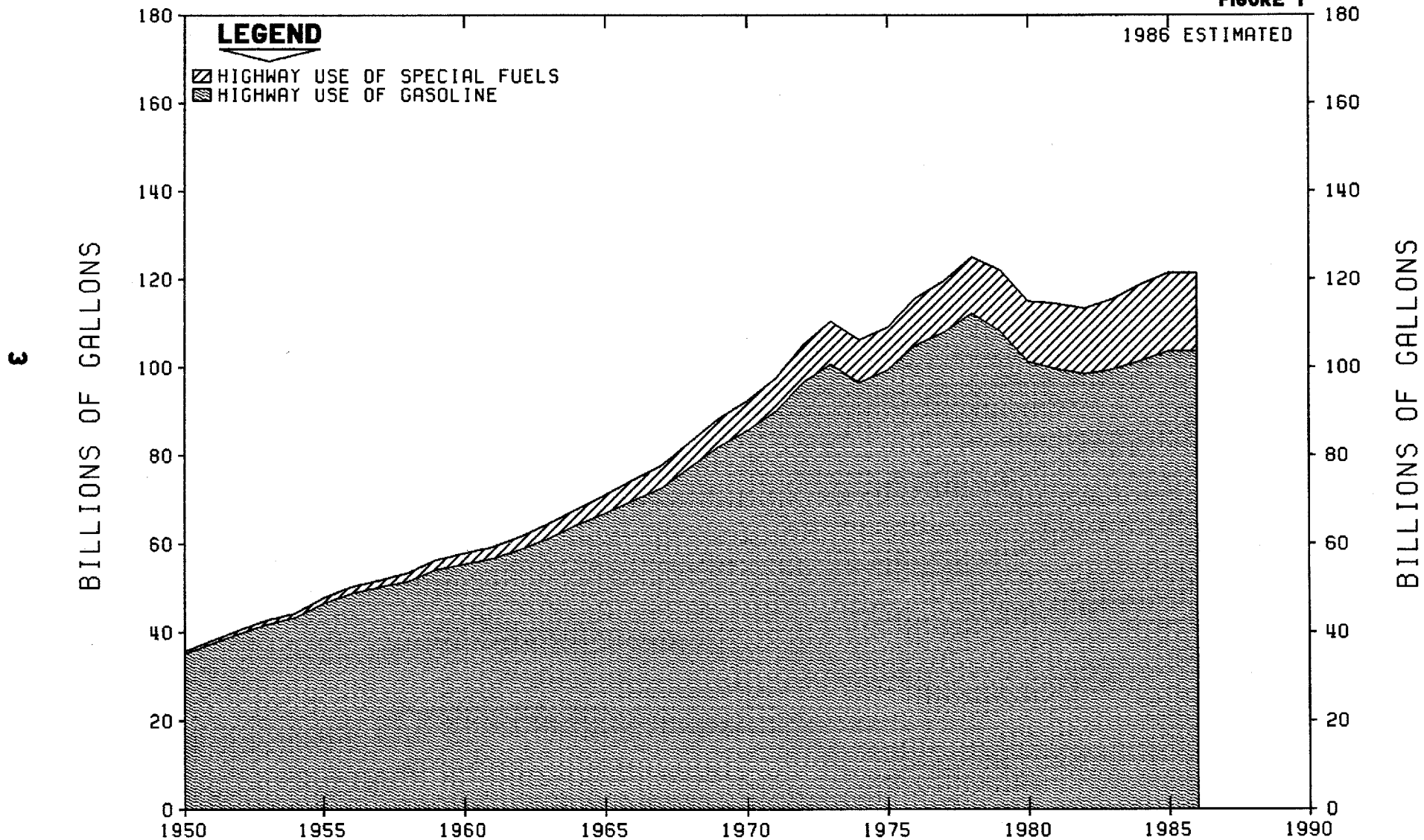
The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 21 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 10 percent of the mileage and carry 69 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 26 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 86 percent of the travel.

MISCELLANEOUS - Expenditures per mile average \$22,990, and \$7,071 per mile for capital outlay and maintenance respectively. State highway-user revenue per 1,000 vehicle miles of travel averaged \$14.67 for all States.

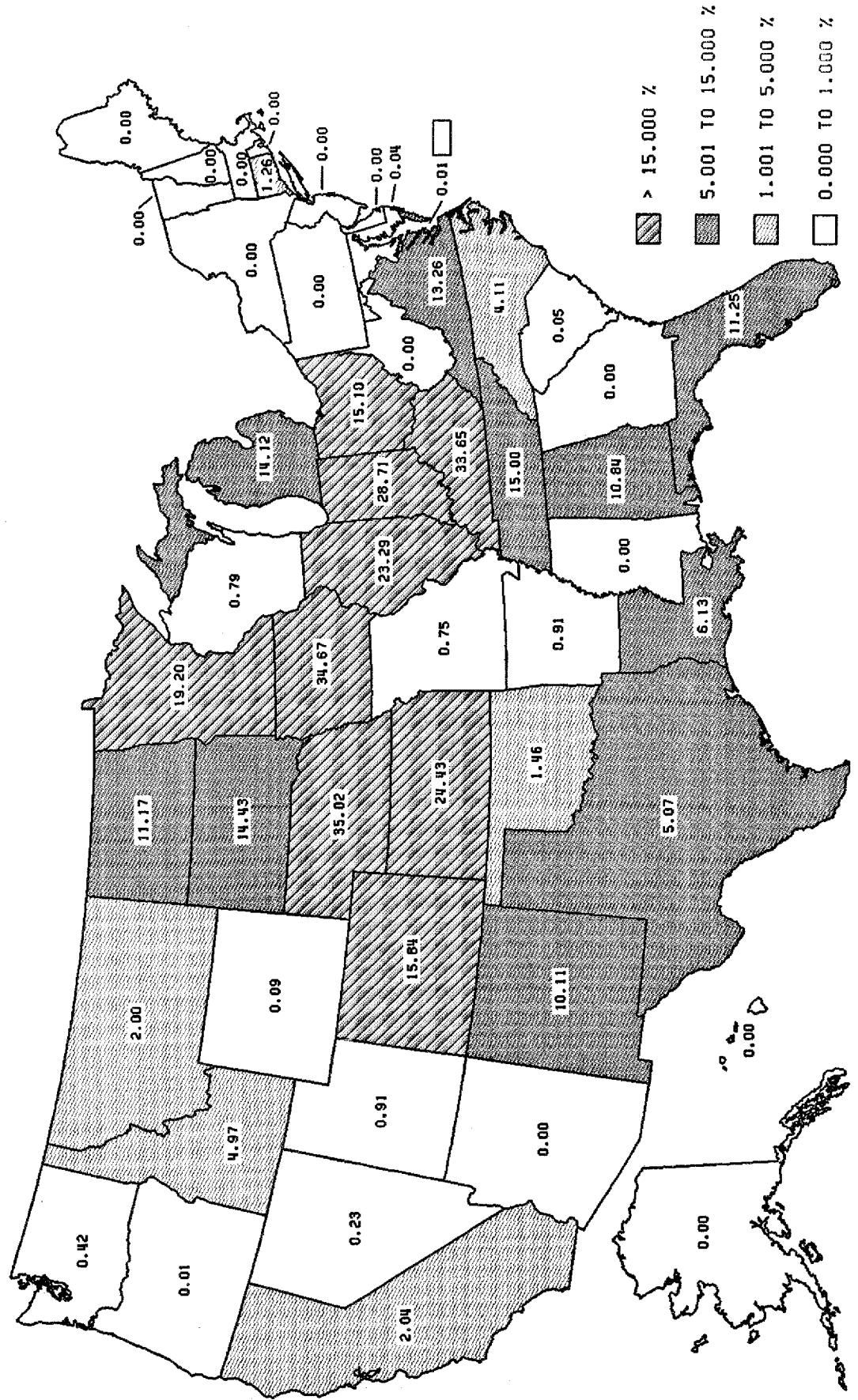

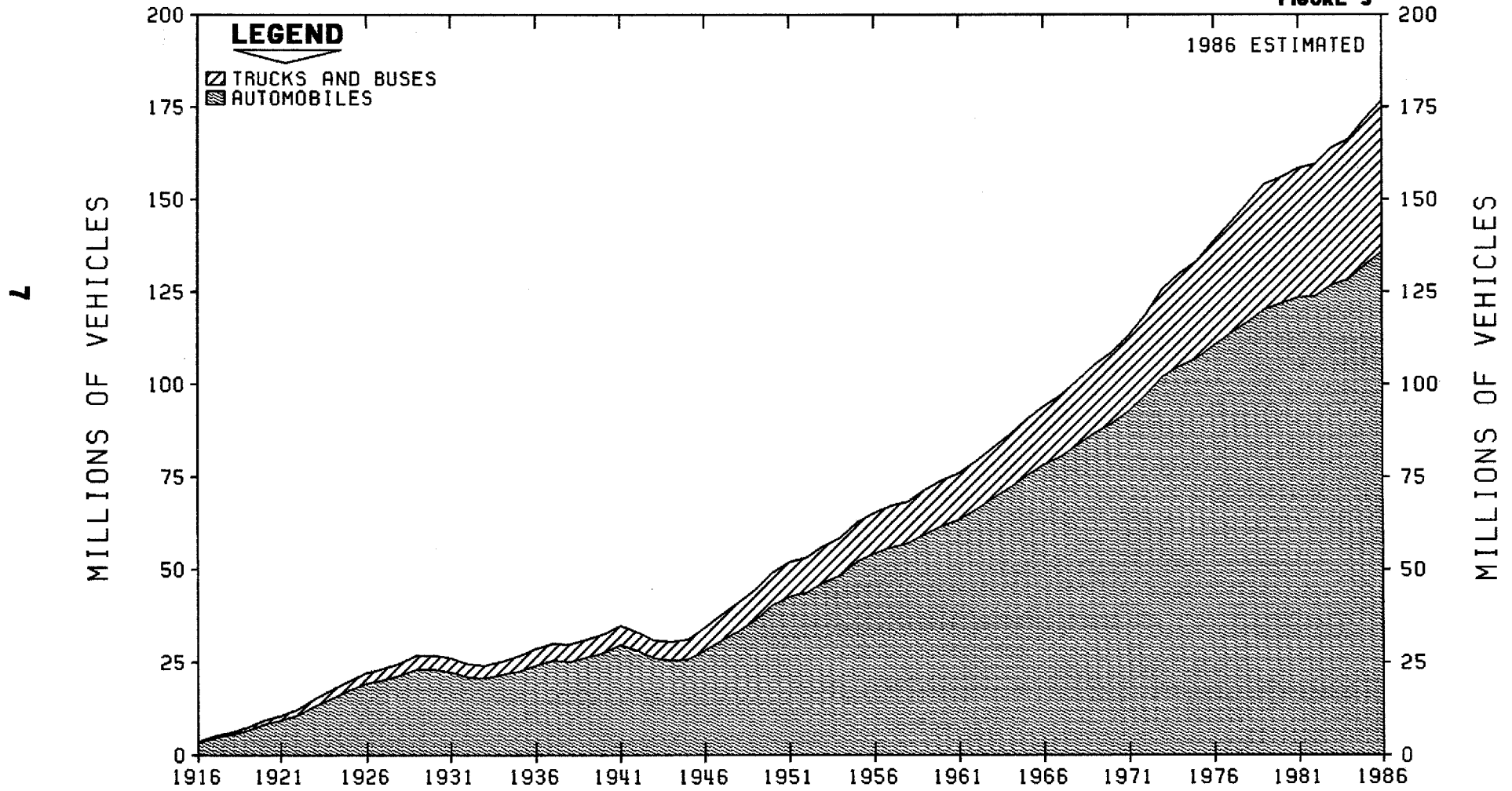
GASOLIN AS A PERCENT OF HIGHWAY USE OF GASOLINE - 1985

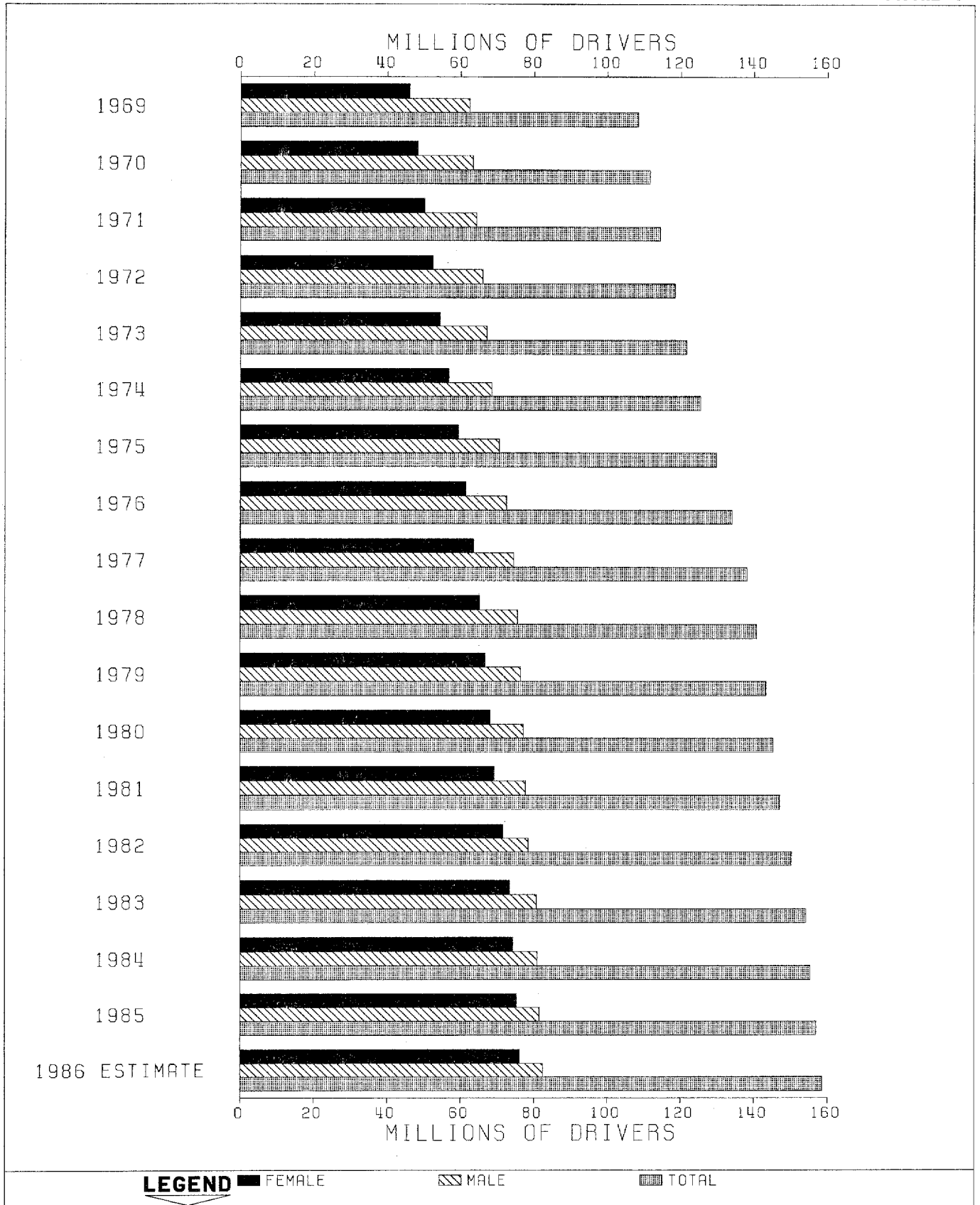

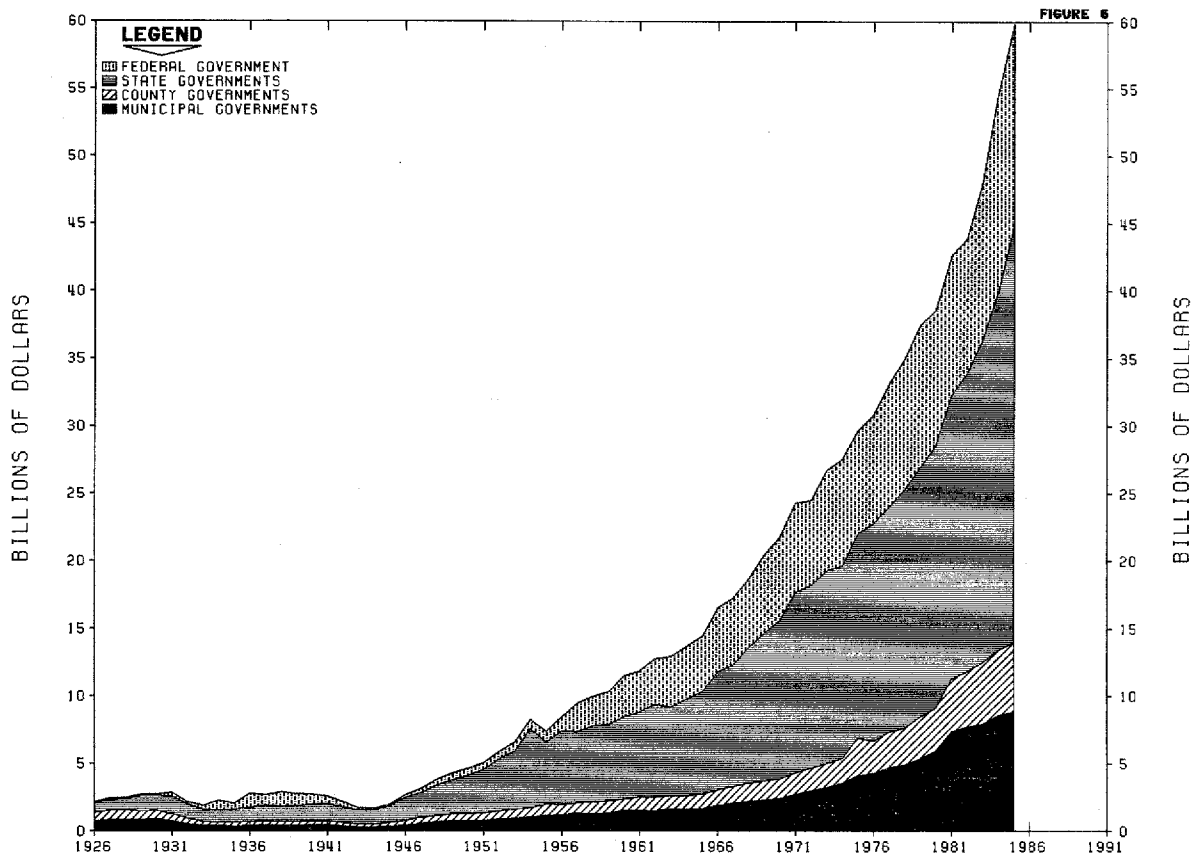

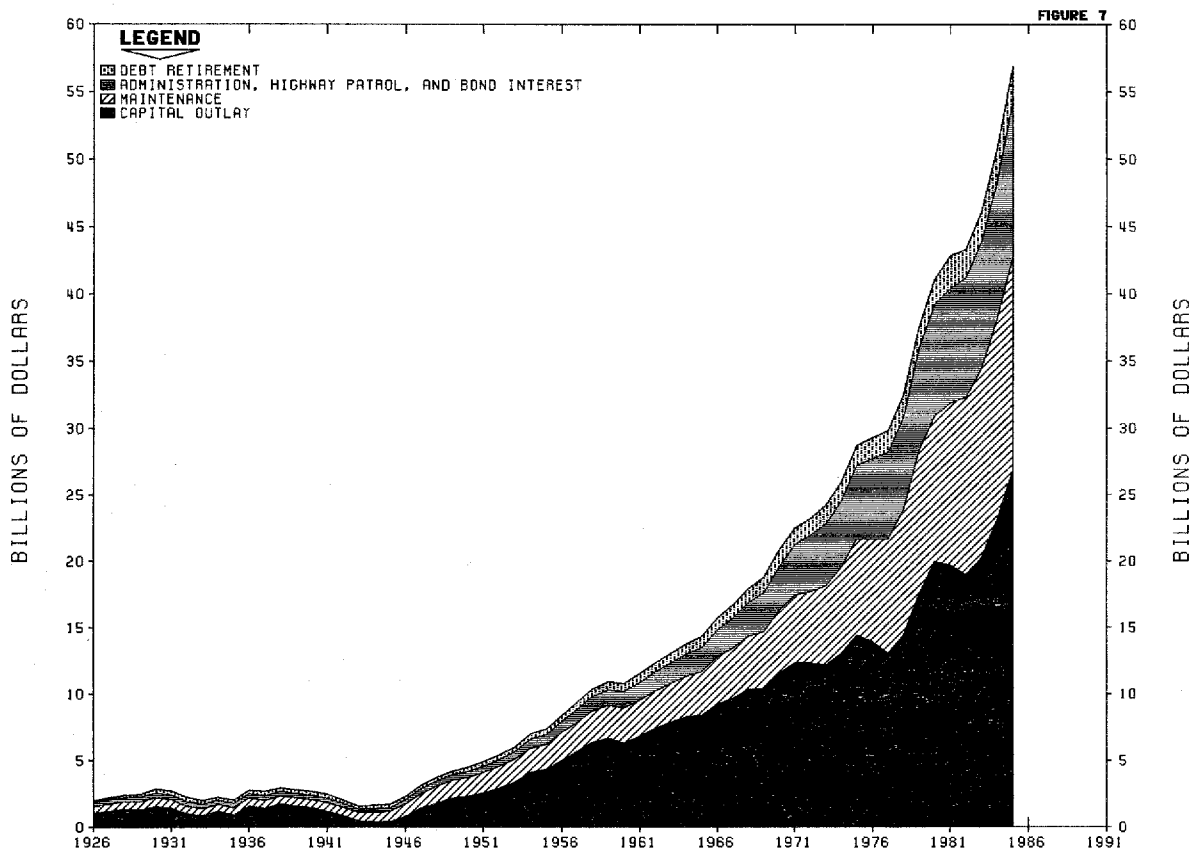

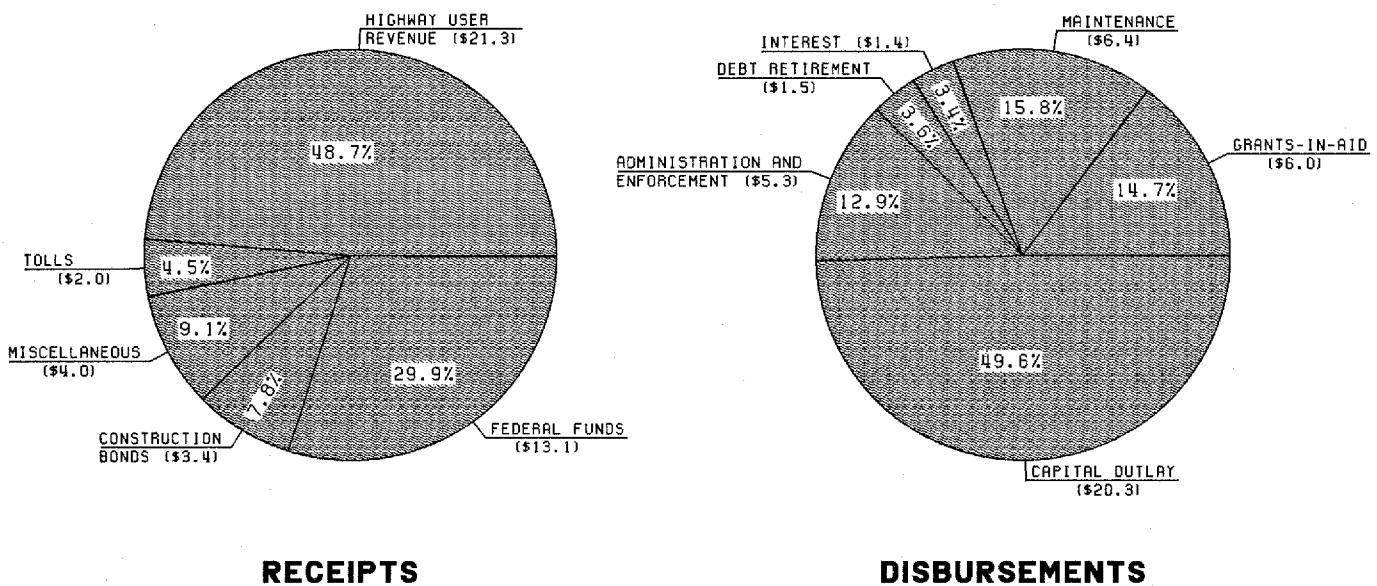

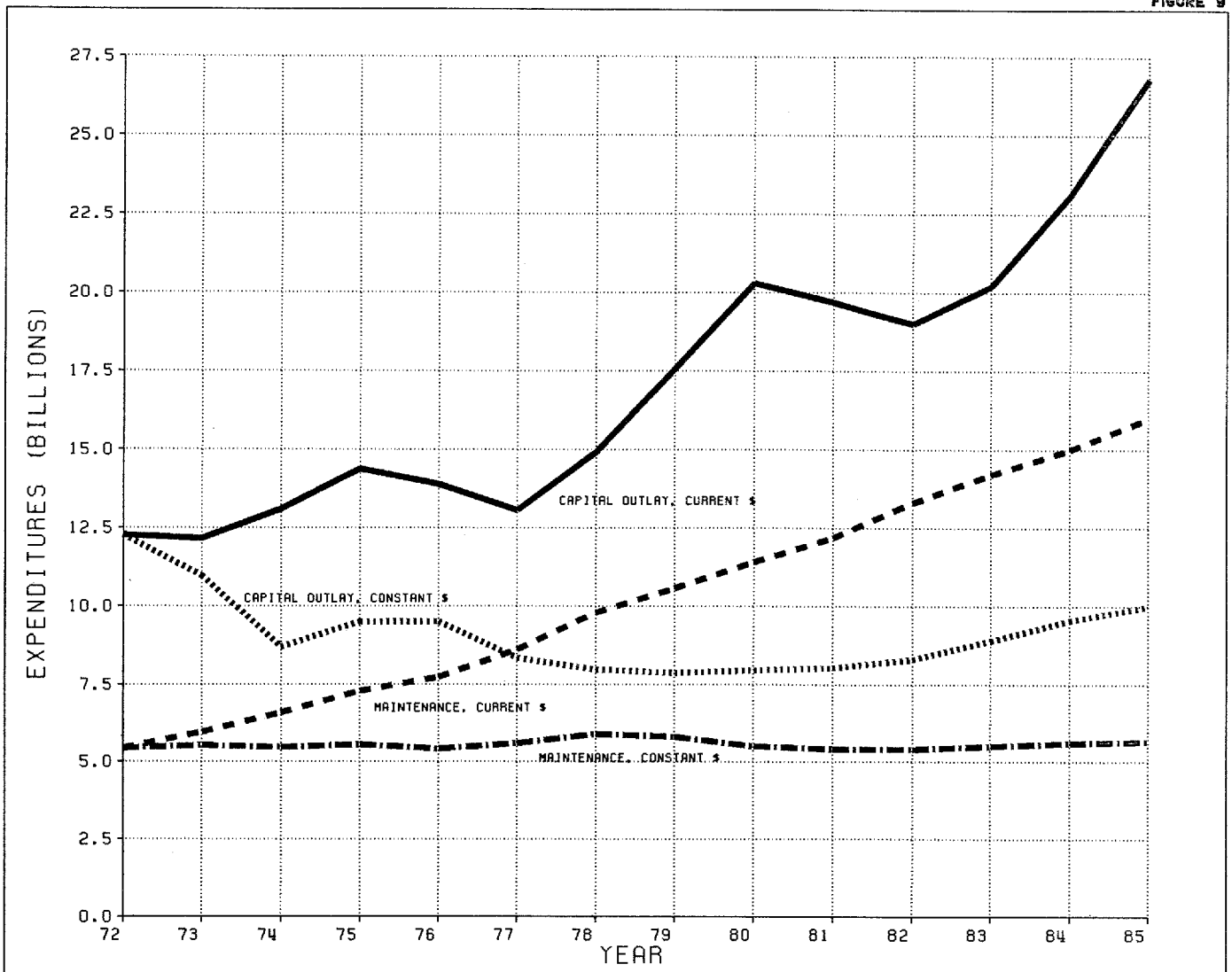

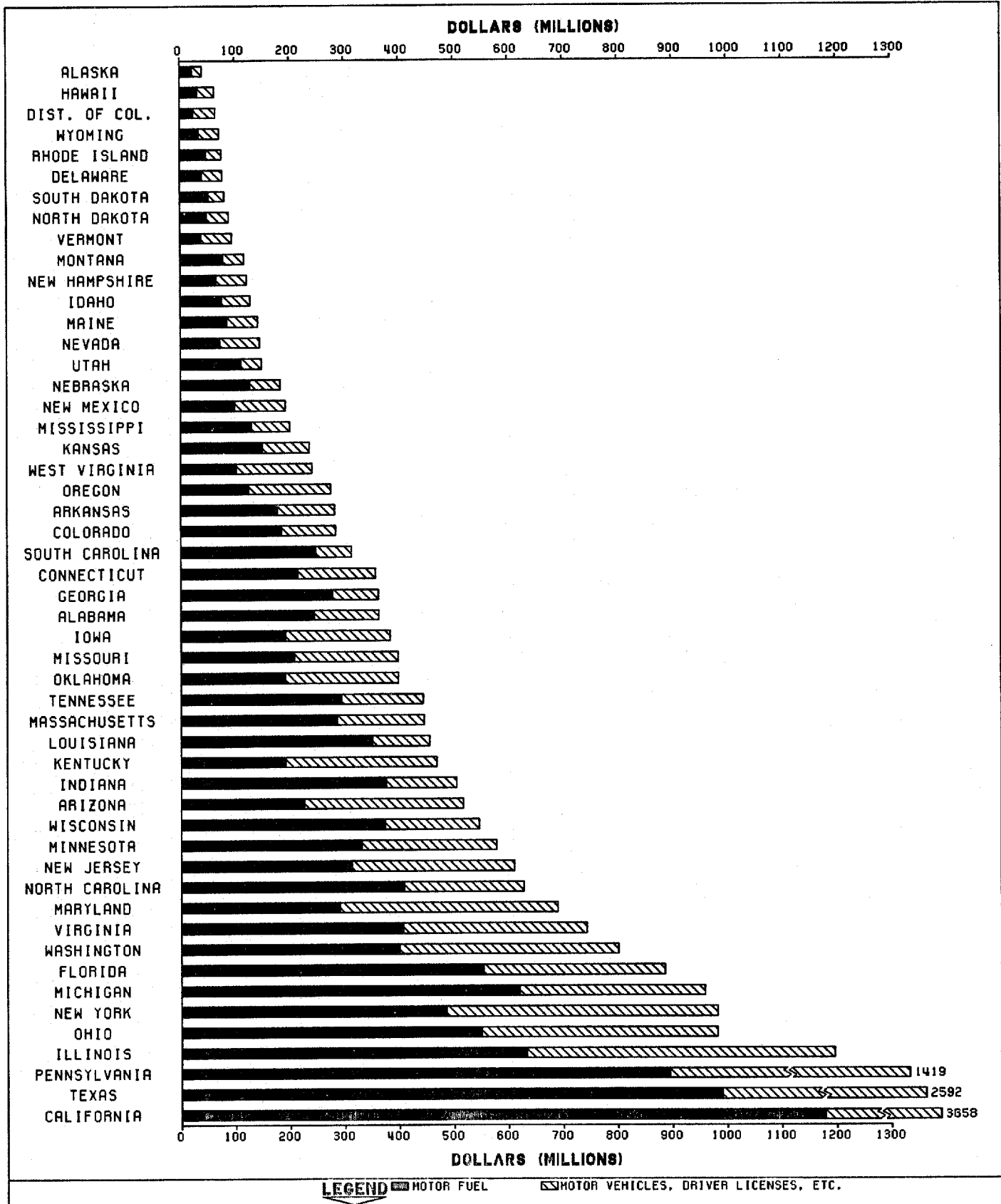
HIGHWAY EXPENDITURES BY ALL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT

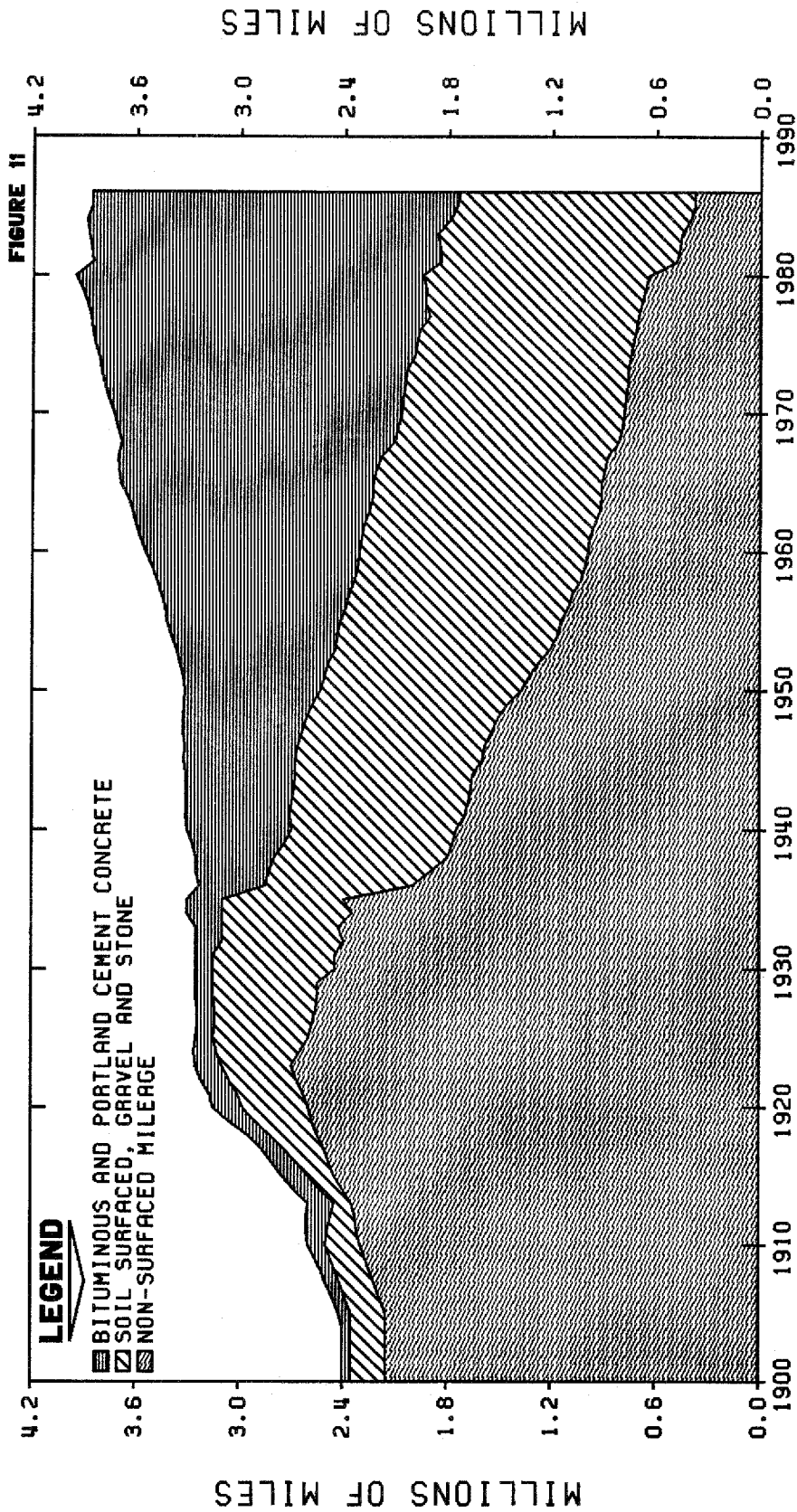

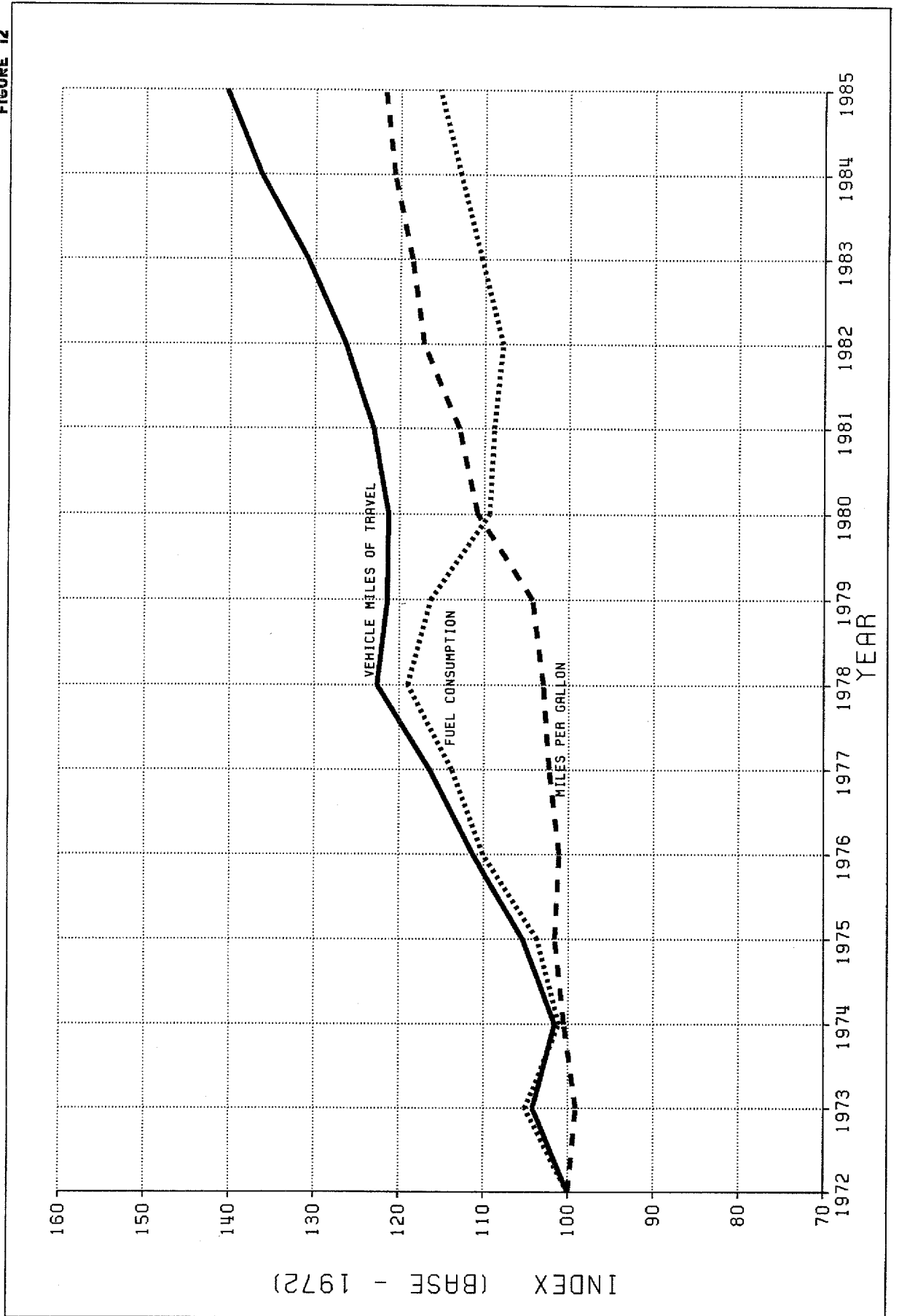

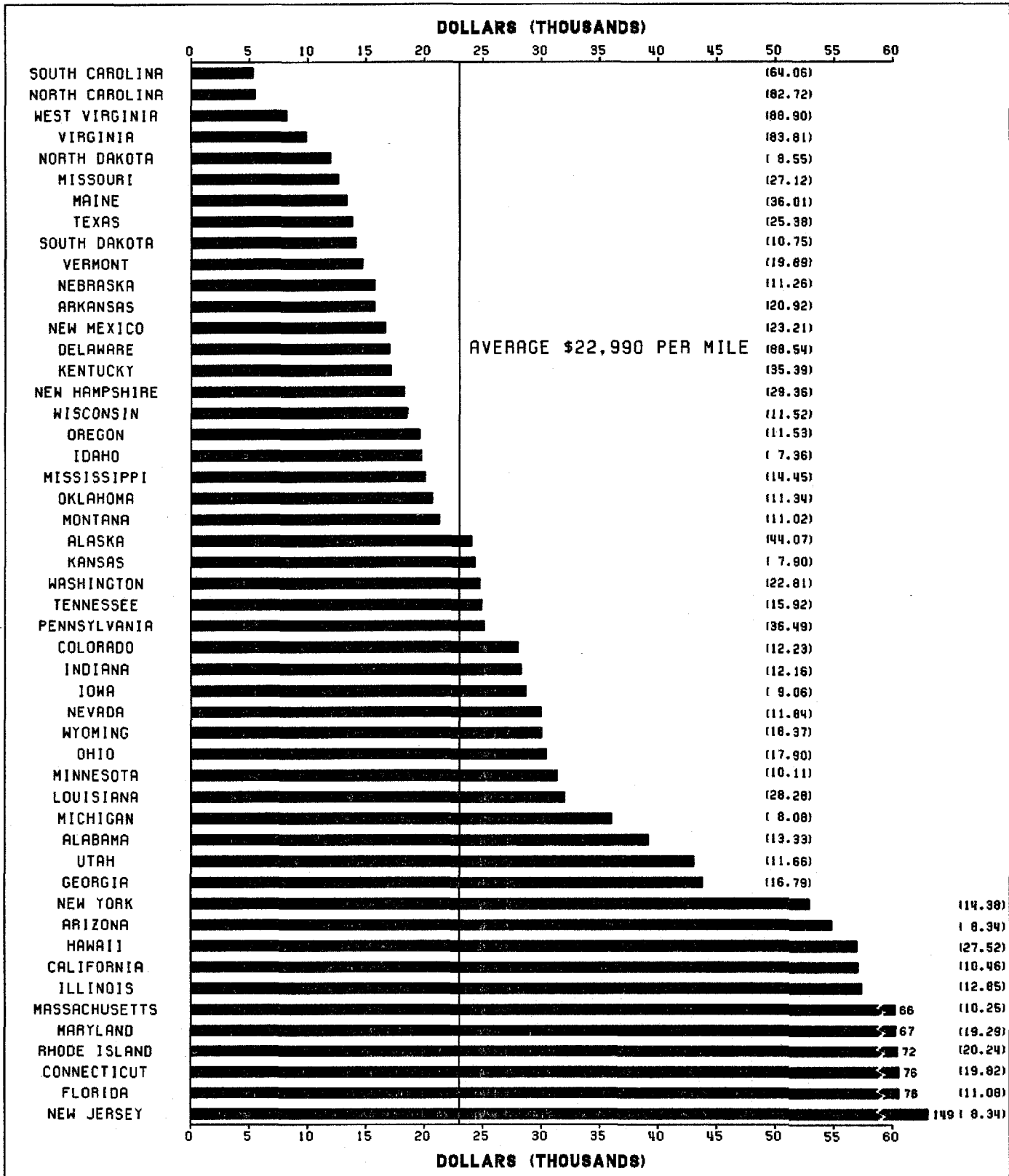

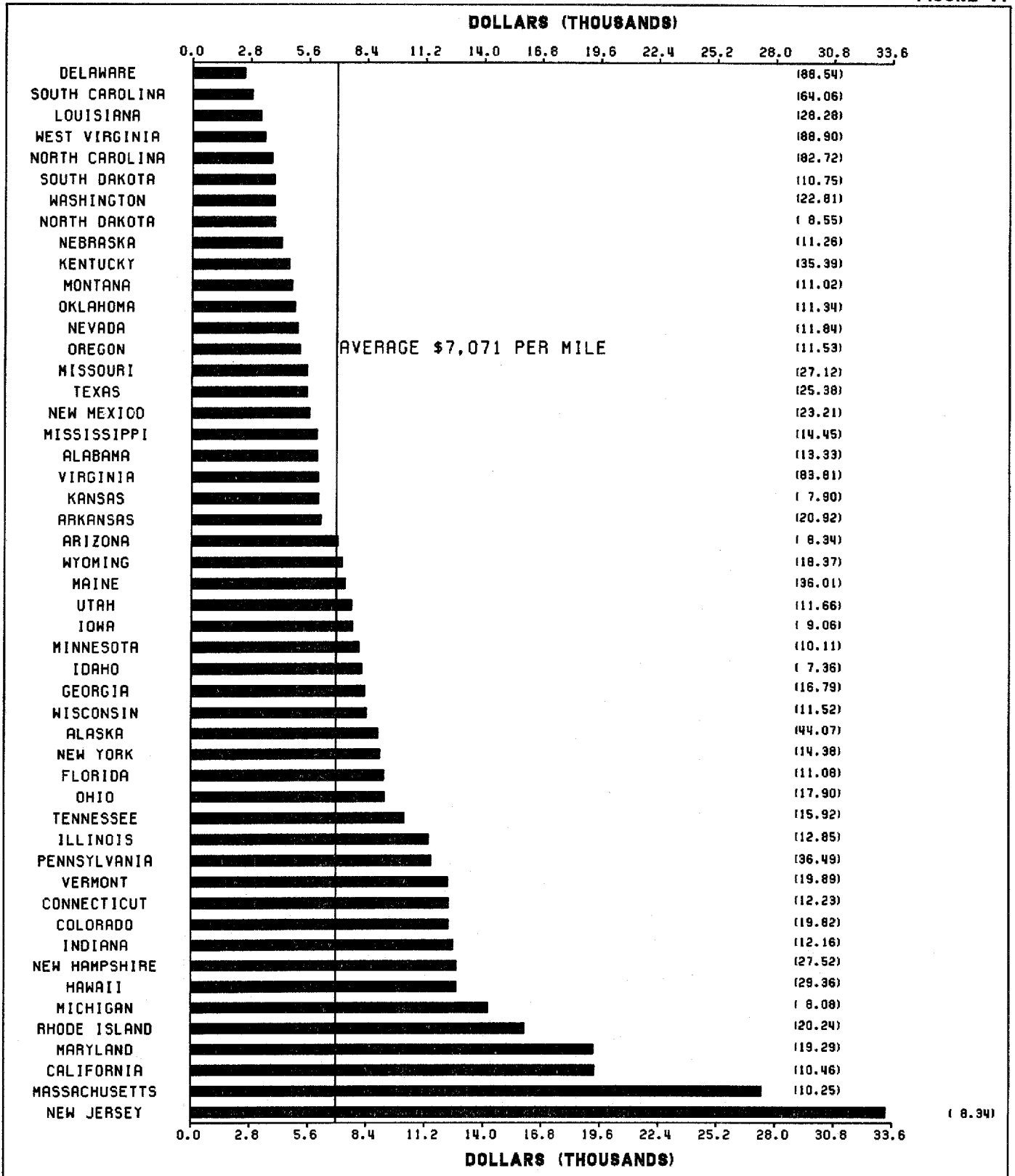

(EXCLUDING TOLL FACILITIES)

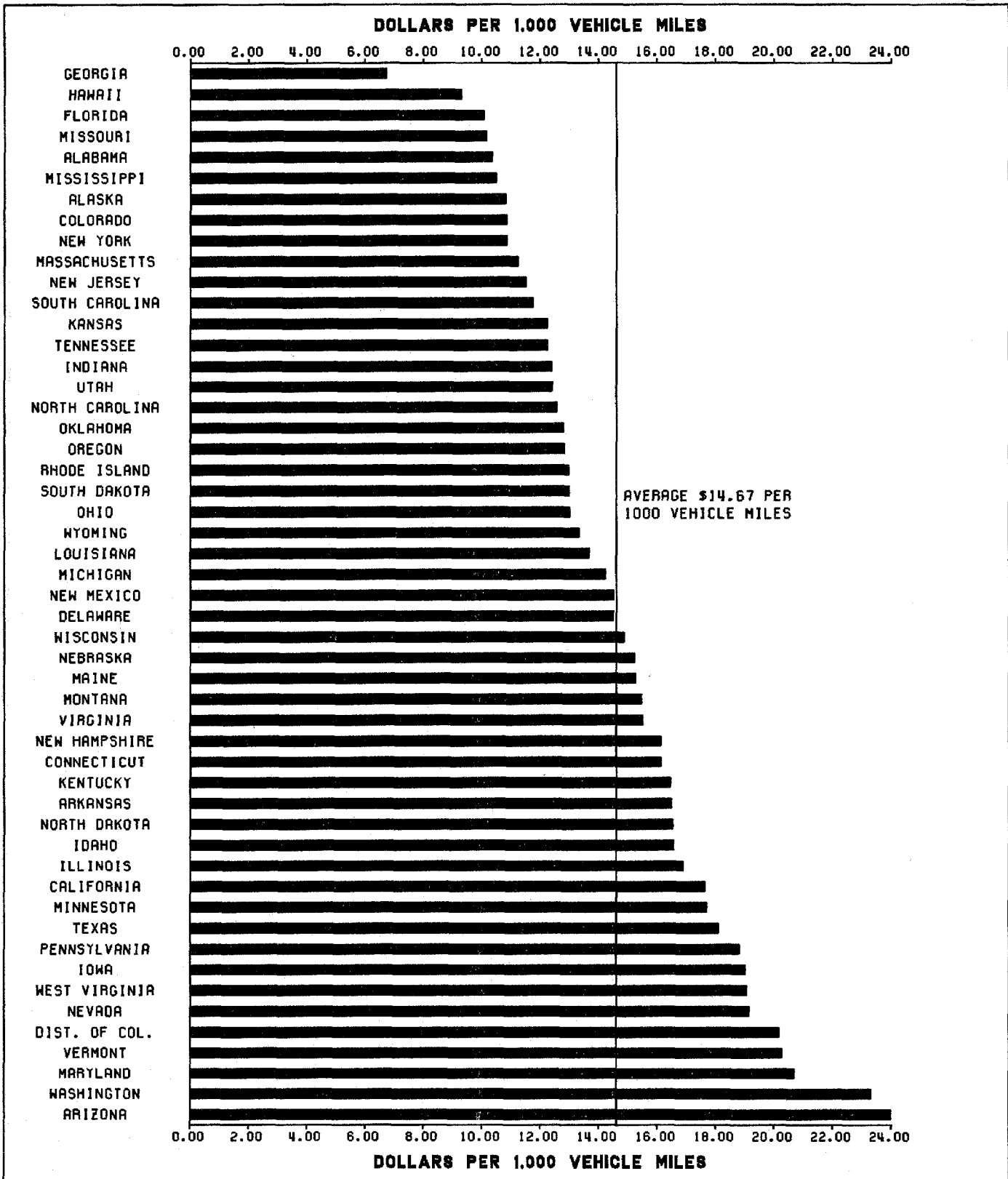

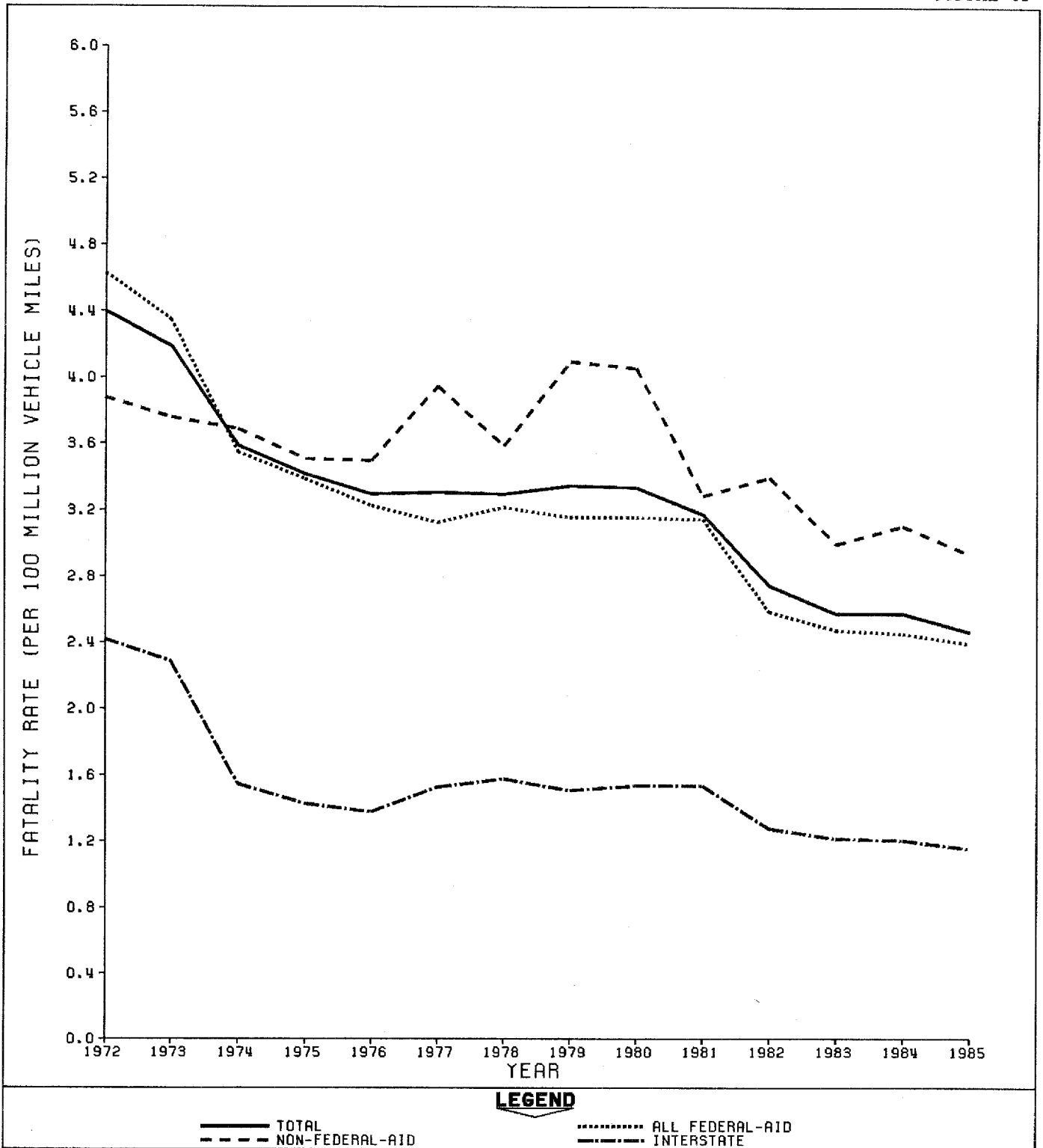
STATE HIGHWAY-USER REVENUE PER VEHICLE MILE OF TRAVEL 1985
