THE REGIONAL OFFICE IS INDEED GRATIFIED BY THE ACTION TAKEN BY THESE COMMUNICATORS AT A TIME WHEN IT IS MANDATORY THAT AIRWAY COMMUNICATION STATIONS BE STAFFED TO THE FULL STRENGTH IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR VITAL SERVICES REQUIRED BY THE ARMED FORCES. THE EIGHTH REGION IS IN FULL ACCORD WITH THE STATEMENT MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR WHICH IS QUOTED HEREWITH: "I RELY UPON EACH OF YOU TO PREVENT FAILURE OF THE C.A.A. TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE IN ALASKA AT THIS TIME WHICH WOULD IMPAIR THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE WAR EFFORT AND DISCREDIT OUR SERVICE".

IT IS THE OPINION OF THIS OFFICE THAT SERVICE IN ALASKA AFFORDS AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY FOR EACH AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR, WHETHER ON A PERMANENT OR VOLUNTEER STATUS, TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE FULLEST EXTENT IN THE SUCCESSFUL PROSECUTION OF THE WAR AND TO RENDER THEIR COUNTRY AN EXTREMELY VALUABLE SERVICE AT THIS TIME.

THE THIRD GROUP OF AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR VOLUNTEERS, TOTALING FIFTY OR MORE, IS EXPECTED TO DEPART FROM THE CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES FOR ALASKA WITHIN THE NEXT FEW DAYS. THESE VOLUNTEERS WILL AUGMENT THE COMPLEMENTS AT STATIONS WHERE SHORTAGE OF PERSONNEL HAS RESULTED IN OVERTIME AND, IN A FEW CASES, CANCELLATION OF THE WEEKLY TIME OFF.

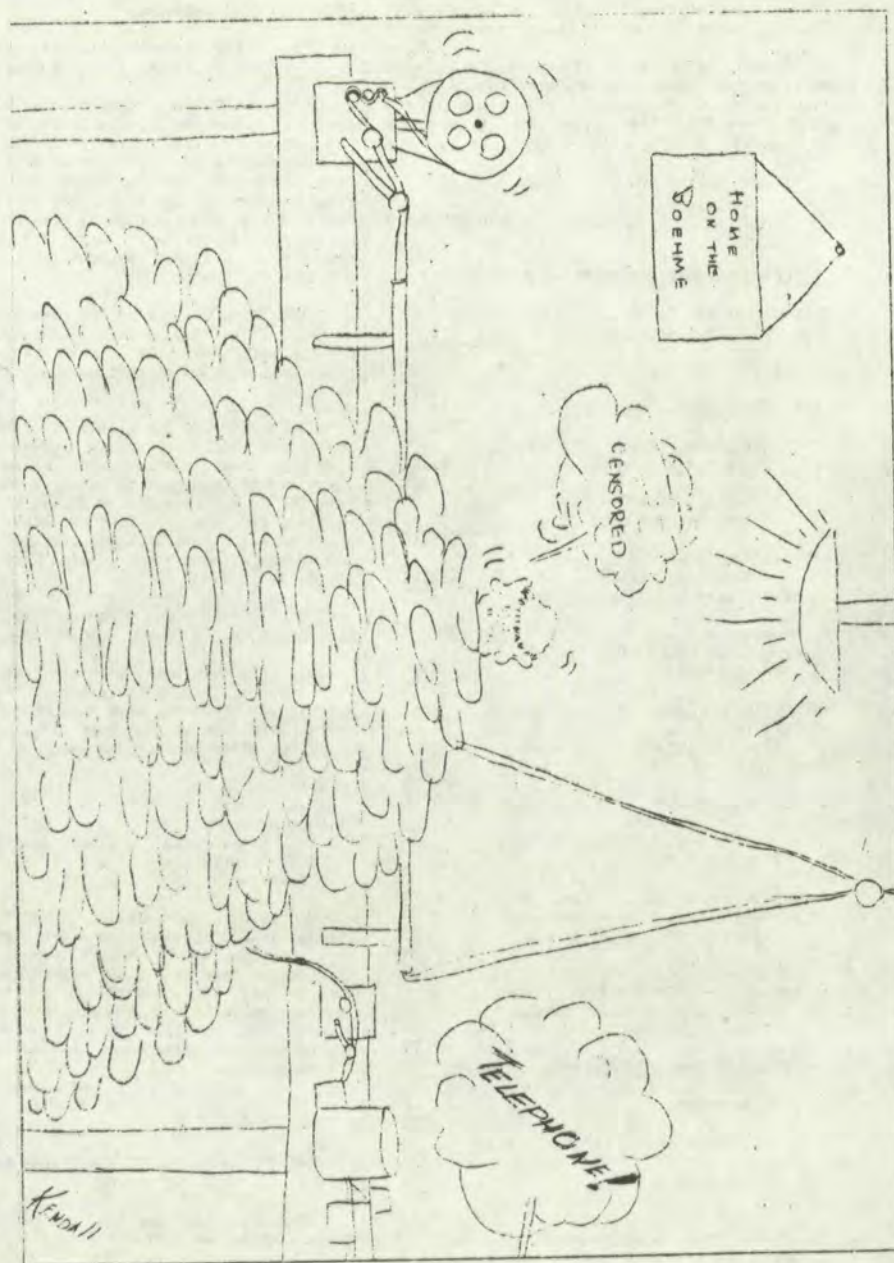

SUBJECT: TRAVEL BY CAA AIRCRAFT

IN THE LIGHT OF RECENT EXPERIENCE, IT APPEARS ADVISABLE TO PROMULGATE CERTAIN REGULATIONS AFFECTING TRAVEL ON CAA AIRCRAFT. THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE THEREFORE MADE EFFECTIVE AS OF THIS DATE.

1. FOR AERODYNAMIC AND AESTHETIC REASONS, DIAPERS MAY NOT BE HUNG OUT THE WINDOWS OF NC18 TO DRY.
