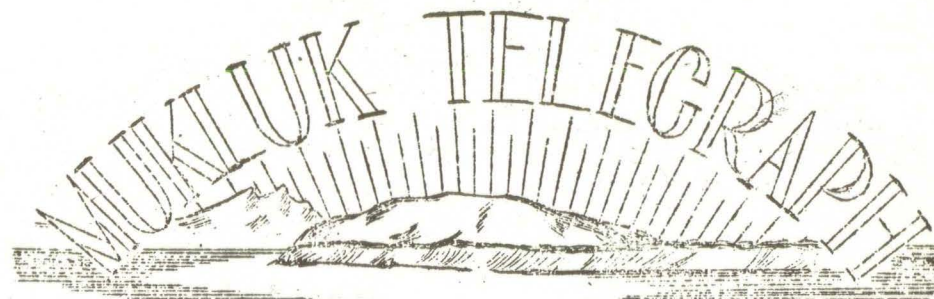

CAA COMPLETES FOURTH YEAR OF SERVICE IN ALASKA

THIS ISSUE OF THE "MUKLUK" MAY BE CONSIDERED AN ANNIVERSARY NUMBER AS IT WAS FOUR YEARS AGO THIS JULY 1 THAT A GROUP OF US ARRIVED TO TAKE OVER THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND ENGINEERING FUNCTIONS OF THE AIRWAYS ENGINEERING DIVISION AND THE CIVIL AERONAUTICS ADMINISTRATION BECAME A REALITY IN ALASKA. PRIOR TO THAT TIME THE GENERAL INSPECTION DIVISION HAD BEEN REPRESENTED IN THE TERRITORY FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS; FIRST BY SHORT ANNUAL VISITS MADE BY INSPECTORS FROM THE CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES; THEN EARLY IN 1934 THEY ESTABLISHED AN OFFICE IN ANCHORAGE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF MURRAY HALL, WHO WAS SUCCEEDED BY HUGH BREWSTER IN THE SUMMER OF 1936. BREWSTER WAS FOLLOWED IN THE SUMMER OF 1938 BY I. K. MCWILLIAMS, WHO ENDEARED HIMSELF TO ALL ALASKAN PILOTS AND THOSE IN THE AVIATION INDUSTRY. MR. MCWILLIAMS ALSO CARRIED ON AFTER THE BUREAU OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS ARRIVED.

FOUR YEARS AGO THERE WERE SIXTEEN MEN IN THE OUR PRESENT ORGANIZATION. THESE PIONEERS WERE: W. DAVIS, MARSHALL C. HOPPIN, HENRY W. LALLY, VERNE E. ROWLEY, ELLSWORTH P. SIMONOS, ELDORGE A. SNIGHT, JOHN H. WASHBURN, ARTHUR S. WATSON, CHARLES F. WAYER, JR., ELMO L. YEASELL, AND MERLE H. YOUNG. OUR OFFICES WERE ANYTHING BUT SPACIOUS, AS WE WERE LOCATED IN TWO ROOMS IN THE OLD ALASKA RAILROAD ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, BUT FROM THERE WE CARRIED ON THE IMPORTANT WORK OF BUILDING THE FIRST FEDERAL AIRWAYS FROM KETCHIKAN, JUNEAU, CORDOVA, ANCHORAGE, AND FAIRBANKS TO NOME. THOSE DAYS WERE JUST AS TRYING AND AS STRENUOUS AS ARE THESE WAR DAYS AND THE LIGHTS BURNED MANY A MORNING UNTIL ONE OR TWO O'CLOCK, BUT 8:30 THE NEXT MORNING FOUND THE "GANG" AT THEIR DESKS AT THEIR NORMAL ROUTINE.

FINALLY WASHINGTON CONCEDED AN INCREASE IN PERSONNEL AND WE WERE ABLE TO OBTAIN STENOGRAPHIC AND OTHER SORELY NEEDED PERSONNEL.

COMMENDATION

IT IS NEEDLESS TO SAY THAT ALL PERSONNEL OF THE EIGHTH REGION HAVE BEEN WORKING UNDER CONSIDERABLE PRESSURE SINCE THE OUTBREAK OF WAR TO DO THE BEST JOB THEY KNOW HOW IN ATTEMPTING TO END THE WORLD CONFLICT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

DURING THE EARLY PART OF THIS YEAR WE WERE CALLED UPON TO EFFECT CERTAIN CIRCUIT ARRANGEMENTS WHICH WOULD IMPROVE COMMUNICATIONS THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY. THIS TEMPORARY EXPEDIENT WAS NECESSITATED BY THE DELAYS IN DELIVERY OF PERMANENT EQUIPMENT WHICH HAS BEEN ON ORDER FOR SOME TIME. THIS WORK WAS UNDERTAKEN DURING THE LATTER PART OF MARCH AND A DEADLINE DATE OF MAY FIRST WAS ESTABLISHED. THE UNTIRING EFFORTS AND THE ENTHUSIASM WITH WHICH OUR PERSONNEL UNDERTOOK THIS WORK RESULTED IN ITS COMPLETION DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF APRIL.

WE ARE IN RECEIPT OF A LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR OF FEDERAL AIRWAYS ON THIS SUBJECT IN WHICH HE PERSONALLY COMMENDS ALL PERSONNEL WHO PARTICIPATED IN THIS EFFORT. HIS LETTER IS QUOTED BELOW:

"THIS OFFICE WISHES TO TAKE THIS OPPORTUNITY TO EXPRESS ITS APPRECIATION OF THE EFFORTS OF ALL PERSONNEL WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF THE TEMPORARY LOW-FREQUENCY FACILITIES IN THE EIGHTH REGION DURING THE MONTH OF MARCH AND THE FIRST WEEK IN APRIL OF THE CURRENT YEAR. THIS ACCOMPLISHMENT SERVES TO STRENGTHEN MY OPINION THAT THE CAA RADIO AND CONSTRUCTION PERSONNEL IN THE EIGHTH REGION HAVE THE ABILITY TO COMPLETE A 'HIGHBALL' PROJECT ONCE THEY HAVE THE MATERIALS AND HAVE THE PROJECT LINED UP.

"IN CLOSING, I CAN ONLY REPEAT THAT THIS ACCOMPLISHMENT HAS BEEN VERY GRATIFYING TO ME AND UNDOUBTEDLY HAS BEEN A CONSIDERABLE CONTRIBUTION TO THE WAR REQUIREMENTS IN THAT TERRITORY."

DUE TO THE VARIED NATURE OF OUR WORK ALL PERSONNEL OF THE REGION MAY CONSIDER THIS COMMENDATION AS AFFECTING THEM, AND IT IS HOPED THAT OUR CONTINUED ENDEAVORS WILL RESULT IN FUTURE ACHIEVEMENTS WORTHY OF FURTHER PRAISE. A GOOD JOB WELL DONE!

UNALAKLEET CAA PERSONNEL RECEIVE COMMENDATION

IN THIS WORLD OF GRIPES AND GROWLS, WE WERE PLEASED TO RECEIVE, THE OTHER DAY, A LETTER FROM MR. E. B. LARSON, WHO IS A MISSIONARY AT UNALAKLEET. EXPRESSING CONCERN OVER THE FACT THAT THE WHITE MAN SO OFTEN BRINGS RUIN TO SOME OF THE NATIVE PEOPLE, HE VOICED HIS APPRECIATION OF THE FACT THAT THE CIVIL AERONAUTICS ADMINISTRATION CONSTRUCTION CREWS AT THE UNALAKLEET STATION DID NOT MINGLE WITH THE NATIVES TO THE POINT OF GIVING THEM DRINKS AND CAUSING ANY UNPLEASANTNESS. MR. LARSON ALSO EXPRESSED APPRECIATION FOR OUR WILLINGNESS TO DO LITTLE THINGS TO HELP THE PEOPLE IN THE VILLAGE. ON THE OTHER HAND, WE RECEIVED FINE COOPERATION FROM THE PEOPLE AT UNALAKLEET AND FROM THE OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES THERE.

THIS IS THE WAY IT SHOULD BE, AND IT IS HOPED THAT OUR AFFAIRS WILL BE CONDUCTED IN A SIMILAR MANNER AT ALL OF OUR STATIONS. THE POSITION OF THE CAA IN THE TERRITORY WILL BE IMPROVED IMMENSURABLY BY SUCH THOUGHTFULNESS, AND BOTH CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATIONS PERSONNEL ARE IN A POSITION TO BENEFIT GREATLY BY INTELLIGENT APPLICATION OF THE GOLDEN RULE TO THEIR DAILY LIVES.

WITH CONTINUAL POUNDING AT THE CLOSED DOORS THEY WERE FINALLY OPENED AND FURTHER EXPANSION WAS PERMITTED. ABOUT THIS TIME WASHINGTON DECIDED ALASKA SHOULD BECOME A REGION AND ON JULY 1, 1941 THE EIGHTH REGION WAS CREATED. WITH INCREASED PROBLEMS AND "GROWING PAINS" WE HAVE HELD FORTH, UNTIL TODAY WE HAVE A TOTAL STAFF OF 725 PERMANENT PERSONNEL IN THE TERRITORY.

ALL WORK IN FORMER YEARS, AND PARTICULARLY THE PAST YEAR AND A HALF, HAS BEEN A DIRECT CONTRIBUTION TO THE WAR EFFORT.

THE FOLLOWING QUOTATION FROM A LETTER RECENTLY RECEIVED FROM MR. STANTON, ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CIVIL AERONAUTICS ADMINISTRATION, INDICATES THE REGARD IN WHICH WASHINGTON HOLDS THE EIGHTH REGION:

"ALL OF US ARE VERY PROUD OF THE PART THE CIVIL AERONAUTICS ADMINISTRATION IS PLAYING IN THE WAR EFFORT IN THAT PART OF THE GLOBE."

PERSONALLY I FEEL THE WORK IN THE EIGHTH REGION IS MORE INTERESTING THAN THAT IN ANY OF THE OTHER REGIONS, EVEN UNDER THE ENORMOUS AMOUNT OF PRESSURE. ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, JULY 8, 1943. CONSIDERABLE INTEREST IS BEING SHOWN AROUND THE COMMUNICATIONS BRANCH CONCERNING THE NEW MANUAL OF OPERATIONS, CHAPTER A, PART 2, RECEIVED A FEW DAYS AGO FROM WASHINGTON. CHAPTER A CANCELS AND SUPERSEDES CHAPTER B PART 9 DATED SEPTEMBER 15, 1938. THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS BULLETIN WAS ORIGINALLY INTENDED TO BE JUNE 1ST; HOWEVER, DUE TO DELAYS IN RECEIPT FROM WASHINGTON AND INTERREGIONAL DISTRIBUTION, THE EFFECTIVE DATE WILL BE WITHHELD UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

BRIEFLY, SOME OF THE HIGH-LIGHTS OF THE NEW CHAPTER A, PART 2, ARE: ALL AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR PERSONNEL WILL BE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN AN AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR "CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY". THESE CERTIFICATES PRESENT A VERY PLEASING APPEARANCE AND ARE SUITABLE FOR FRAMING AND WILL BE POSTED CONSPICUOUSLY IN THE COMMUNICATIONS STATIONS. STUDY MATERIALS TO PREPARE COMMUNICATIONS PERSONNEL FOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATIONS WILL BE FURNISHED TO ALL COMMUNICATIONS STATIONS AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE. IT IS BELIEVED THAT COMMUNICATORS QUALIFYING FOR THESE CERTIFICATES WILL HAVE AN EXCELLENT KNOWLEDGE OF THE PROBLEMS CONFRONTING AIRMEN AND BE IN A POSITION TO RENDER EFFICIENT INVALUABLE SERVICES TO THEM.

FOR PERSONNEL OBTAINING THE ABOVE SPEEDS THIS OFFICE WILL ISSUE LETTERS OF EXEMPTION WHICH WILL EXCUSE THEM FROM FUTURE OPERATING TESTS FOR A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS UNLESS THEY INDICATE THEIR DESIRE TO BE REEXAMINED PRIOR TO THAT TIME.

THIS OFFICE HAS RECEIVED NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONCERNING THE COMMUNICATION STATION RECLASSIFICATION. IT IS HOPED THAT WE WILL HAVE FURTHER INFORMATION ON THIS PROJECT PRIOR TO THE NEXT ISSUE.

IN LIEU THEREOF - IN THE EVENT ITS PROFOUND DEPTH IS FOUND BEYOND NORMAL UNDERSTANDING - HANG UP A GIRLIE PICTURE IN THAT SPOT INSTEAD. IT WILL BE SOFTER ON THE EYES AND PERSONNEL WILL PAY MORE ATTENTION TO IT.

2. THAT NEW AND RELATIVELY INEXPERIENCED OPERATORS NOT SEND ANY FASTER THAN THEY CAN RECEIVE. IN THE BEST OF CIRCLES IT IS CONSIDERED SOCIALLY CORRECT TO KEEP ONES SENDING CALMED DOWN TO A LEVEL WITH ONE'S RECEIVING.
