### ANCHORAGE HOUSING PROJECT NEARS COMPLETION

MOST OF THE CNA HOUSES ARE NOW FINISHED AND OCCUPIED. FOR MONTHS ANCHORAGE CNA PERSONNEL, LIVING IN DRAFTY SHACKS AND COOKING ON SMOKING OIL STOVES, HAVE BEEN LOOKING HOPEFULLY IN THE DIRECTION OF 11TH AND P TO 13TH AND BIRCH WAY, WHERE THE ROWS OF TRIM, MODERN HOMES WERE UNDER CONSTRUCTION. NOW THESE SAME EMPLOYEES ARE COMFORTABLY FIXED IN WARM, COMPLETELY FURNISHED FIVE ROOM HOUSES BUILT WITH MONEY ADVANCED BY THE FEDERAL HOUSING ADMINISTRATION. NO WONDER THE MORALE IS HIGH DESPITE THE SHORTENING DAYS AND THE NIPPY MORNINGS.

AT PRESENT 22 OF THE 40 UNITS ARE OCCUPIED. EACH UNIT CONSISTS OF A KITCHEN (WITH BIG ELECTRIC STOVE AND A WHOLE WALL OF CUPBOARDS), A LIVING ROOM (NOTE THE ATTRACTIVE FURNITURE), 2 BEDROOMS (COMFORTABLE BEDS AND PLENTY OF WARM BLANKETS), A BATHROOM (WITH A REAL, HONEST "GOODNESS" BATHTUB) AND A UTILITY ROOM (HOT WATER HEATER AND AN ELECTRIC REFRIGERATOR BIG ENOUGH FOR THANKSGIVING DINNER LEFTOVERS).

THERE IS A CENTRAL HEATING UNIT TO KEEP THE HOUSES WARM. NEXT WINTER WE WON'T NEED TO BURN OIL IN GALLON CANS NOR RUSH HOME AT FIVE O'CLOCK TO SEE IF THE PUMPING IS FROZEN.

AT PRESENT MOST OF THE OCCUPANTS OF THE CNA HOUSING PROJECT ARE KEEPING THEIR YOUTHFUL FIGURES BY WALKING TO AND FROM WORK, BUT WE HOPE TO HAVE BUS SERVICE WITHIN THE NEAR FUTURE.

MRS. THORA MAGELSEN IS THE CNA HOUSING ADMINISTRATOR. SHE IS DOING A SPLENDID JOB IN LEADING THE CNA'ERS TO GET COMFORTABLY SETTLED IN THEIR NEW HOMES.

# AN OPEN LETTER FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT OF AIRWAYS

AS A WHOLE, ALL OF OUR FELLOW WORKERS HAVE DONE AN EXCEPTIONALLY GOOD JOB IN BOTH OUR INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL RELATIONSHIPS; HOWEVER, THERE HAVE BEEN INSTANCES IN THE PAST, AND THEY PROBABLY WILL OCCUR IN THE FUTURE, WHERE SOME OF OUR PEOPLE HAVE SHOWN MORE THAN A NORMAL DIFFIDENT ATTITUDE TOWARD OTHERS WITHIN AND OUTSIDE OF OUR ORGANIZATION. THIS CONDITION, IF ALLOWED TO EXIST AND GROW, MAY EVENTUALLY CAUSE DIRE RESULTS AND A COMPLETE BREAKDOWN OF THE MORALE OF OUR FAMILY.

CONCENTRATED THOUGHT GIVEN TO THIS MATTER WILL REVEAL THAT IN MOST CASES THE PROBLEMS OF ALL PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO OUTLYING AND REMOTE STATIONS ARE MUTUAL, REGARDLESS OF THE ORGANIZATION INVOLVED. IN THE CASE OF THE MILITARY, MOST OF THE PERSONNEL SO ASSIGNED HAD NO PREFERENCE BUT WERE ORDERED TO THE PARTICULAR POST TO PERFORM CERTAIN ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS. THERE MIGHT ARISE CERTAIN INSTANCES WHEN IT MAY APPEAR THAT RESTRICTIONS OR REGULATIONS ARE BEING IMPOSED WHICH ARE DETRIMENTAL TO PERSONAL CONVENIENCE OR COMFORT, AND WHICH APPEAR TO BE NEEDLESS. WHEN CONFRONTED WITH SUCH CONDITIONS, ATTEMPT TO STUDY THEM CAREFULLY AND FEEL FREE TO DISCUSS THEM WITH PROPER PARTIES BEFORE FORMULATING OPINIONS AND ANTAGONISTIC ATTITUDES. IN THE MAJORITY OF INSTANCES, YOU WILL FIND A SATISFACTORY SOLUTION TO THE PARTICULAR PROBLEM AND WILL BE IN A MUCH BETTER FRAME OF MIND. WITH REGARD TO OFFICIAL RELATIONSHIPS, CHANNELS OF ORGANIZATION HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED THRU WHICH DIFFERENCES OF OPINION CAN BE SETTLED TO THE BEST INTERESTS OF ALL CONCERNED. WHEN SUCH DIFFERENCES ARISE, EFFORTS SHOULD BE MADE THRU THESE CHANNELS TO ARRIVE AT A MUTUALLY SATISFACTORY AGREEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED POLICIES AND PROCEDURES AND WHEN SUCH AN AGREEMENT IS NOT POSSIBLE, THE ENTIRE MATTER WITH SUBSTANTIATING FACTS SHOULD BE REFERRED TO HIGHER AUTHORITY.

IT SHOULD BE REMEMBERED BY ALL OF US, THAT THE WELFARE, PEACE OF MIND, AND COMFORT OF ALL CAA EMPLOYEES, ESPECIALLY THOSE ASSIGNED TO REMOTE STATIONS, IS ONE OF THE PRIMARY CONCERNS OF THE REGIONAL OFFICE STAFF. THIS ATTITUDE IS SHARED BY THE MILITARY AND OTHER AGENCIES TOWARD THEIR RESPECTIVE FIELD ORGANIZATIONS. CONSEQUENTLY, ALL OF US SHOULD MAKE CONTINUED ATTEMPTS TO DEVELOP A SPIRIT OF UNDERSTANDING WHICH WILL GO FAR TOWARD IMPROVING RELATIONSHIPS WITH OTHERS AND WILL MAKE MUCH EASIER THE JOB WE SET OUT TO DO, I.E., WHIP THE JAPS!!!

PENDING RECEIPT OF THE MANUAL OF OPERATIONS, CHAPTER A, PART 1, WHEREIN AUTHORIZED STATION COMPLMENTS WILL BE SHOWN NUMERICALLY TOGETHER WITH OTHER INFORMATION CONCERNING THE AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR RECLASSIFICATION, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WILL NO DOUBT BE FOUND TO BE OF INTEREST TO COMMUNICATOR PERSONNEL IN THE FIELD. DEPARTMENTAL APPROVAL HAS BEEN RECEIVED OF THE COMMUNICATIONS DIVISION RECLASSIFICATION OF ALL COMMUNICATIONS STATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CONTINENTAL UNITED STATES AND ALASKA, WHICH SEGREGATES THESE STATIONS INTO TWO MAIN CLASSES; NAMELY, INTERSTATE COMMUNICATION STATION, AND OVERSEAS COMMUNICATION STATION. THE GRADE STRUCTURE OF INTERSTATE COMMUNICATION STATIONS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: CHIEF AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR, CAF-9, SENIOR AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR, CAF-8, AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR, CAF-7, ASSISTANT AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR, CAF-5; THE GRADE STRUCTURE OF OVERSEAS COMMUNICATION STATIONS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: CHIEF OVERSEAS COMMUNICATOR, CAF-10, SENIOR OVERSEAS COMMUNICATOR, CAF-9, OVERSEAS COMMUNICATOR, CAF-8, ASSISTANT OVERSEAS COMMUNICATOR, CAF-6. THE POSITION OF COMMUNICATOR TRAINEE IS TO BE REALLOCATED FROM CAF-2 TO CAF-4. THIS WILL NOT MATERIALLY AFFECT THE EIGHTH REGION SINCE BASIC TRAINING IS TO BE DISCONTINUED, AND THE TRAINING AND PERFORMANCE UNIT NOW IN OPERATION WILL DEVOTE FULL ENERGY TOWARDS THE DEVELOPMENT OF ADVANCED TRAINING AND REFRESHER COURSES.

THE EFFECTIVE DATE ON THE AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR REALLOCATION IS CONTINGENT UPON THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS. THEREFORE, SINCE FUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE AT THE MOMENT, AND NO INFORMATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED FROM WASHINGTON INDICATING THE DATE UPON WHICH THEY CAN BE EXPECTED, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO ESTIMATE WITH ANY DEGREE OF ACCURACY CONCERNING THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

DURING THE INTERIM NO TIME IS TO BE LOST IN ARRANGING FOR THE SPECIAL TRAINING NECESSARY FOR EACH AND EVERY AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR BEFORE HE CAN BE REALLOCATED TO THE HIGHER GRADES WHICH CALL FOR AN INCREASE IN BASIC RESPONSIBILITY.

A STUDY COURSE IS NOW BEING DEVELOPED IN THE EIGHTH REGION TRAINING CENTER COVERING FLIGHT INFORMATION SERVICE AS OUTLINED IN CHAPTER 9, PART 9, METEOROLOGY FOR PILOTS, AND PILOTS' RADIO MANUAL, WHICH WILL BE FIRST ADMINISTERED TO COMMUNICATIONS INSPECTORS AND IMMEDIATELY THEREAFTER TO CHIEF AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATORS, PLUS AS MANY AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATORS IN FUTURE CLASSES AS AVAILABLE FUNDS WILL ACCOMMODATE. FOLLOWING TRAINING OF CHIEF AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATORS, IT IS NOW PROPOSED THAT THEY SHALL RETURN TO THEIR POINTS OF DUTY AND ADMINISTER CERTAIN COURSE OUTLINES AND TRAINING SCHEDULES TO AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATORS UNDER THEIR JURISDICTION. IT IS NOW BELIEVED THAT IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR PERSONNEL TO HOLD CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY FOR THE GRADES INVOLVED PRIOR TO RECEIVING THE HIGHER SALARIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE REALLOCATION.

THE NEW DUTIES WHICH WE AS COMMUNICATORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PERFORM ARE EXACTING, REQUIRE FULL APPRECIATION OF THE RESPONSIBILITIES CONNECTED THEREWITH AND THE ABILITY TO EXECUTE CERTAIN SPECIFIC PROCEDURES WITHOUT DELAY, THE PRIME OBJECTIVE BEING TO TRAIN PERSONNEL OF ALL BRANCHES OF THE FEDERAL AIRWAYS SERVICE SO AS TO PROVIDE THE PILOT IN THE AIR WITH UNERRING INFORMATION LOOKING TO THE SAFE CONCLUSION OF HIS FLIGHT, UNDER THE CONDITIONS PREVALENT AT THAT TIME. FOR SOME YEARS PAST, AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATORS HAVE BEEN PROVIDING FLIGHT INFORMATION SERVICE, BUT HAVE BEEN DOING SO WITH CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE LIMITATIONS WHICH THE RECLASSIFICATION, ESPECIALLY STATION GRADATIONS, NOW ELIMINATES.

JOB DESCRIPTIONS AS WELL AS A DESCRIPTION OF THE DUTIES OF INCUMBENT COMMUNICATORS AND METHOD PROPOSED FOR SELECTION AND UPGRADING WILL BE FURNISHED IN GREATER DETAIL AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE.

# TRAINING UNIT BRIEFS

PROBABLY THE OUTSTANDING CODE SPEED RECEIVING SCORE YET RECORDED IN THE TRAINING UNIT WAS CHALKED UP RECENTLY BY MR. ALBERT C. FRAZIER IN ATTAINING A SPEED OF 40 WORDS PER MINUTE WITH LESS THAN FIVE PERCENT ERROR. STARTING FROM SCRATCH SEVERAL MONTHS AGO, FRAZIER HAS DEVELOPED HIS RECEIVING PROFICIENCY TO A POINT CONSIDERED GOOD EVEN FOR EXPERIENCED OPERATORS.

RECENT FIELD ASSIGNMENTS: MR. AND MRS. RICHARD C. COLLINS, NORTHWAY; MR. AND MRS. ALBERT C. FRAZIER, TANANA; MR. AND MRS. JOSEPH A. FISHER, TANACROSS; MR. AND MRS. GUINN E. METZGER, BIG DELTA; MR. AND MRS. LUTHER M. NOEY, KOTZEBUE; MR. AND MRS. JAMES A. SEITZ, GULKANA; MR. AND MRS. KERNIT R. SLOAN, SHEEP MOUNTAIN; MR. AND MRS. JOHN B. TAYLOR, YAKUTAGAI; AND MR. JOEL WING, BRUIN BAY.

MOUNTING INTEREST IS EVIDENCED IN THE NAVIGATIONAL AND METEOROLOGICAL ASPECTS OF THE FLIGHT COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE, BOTH IN THE FIELD AND IN THE TRAINING UNIT. IN ADDITION TO MOVING OF GREAT VALUE IN IMPROVING THE COMMUNICATOR'S ABILITY TO RENDER MORE EFFICIENT SERVICE TO THE "MAN IN THE AIR", A NUMBER OF STUDENTS WHO ARE ALSO UNDERGOING FLIGHT TRAINING IN THEIR OWN HAVE FOUND THAT THIS STUDY ENABLES THEM TO HANDLE THE NAVIGATIONAL AND METEOROLOGICAL ELEMENTS OF THE PRIVATE PILOT'S EXAMINATION WITH EASE.

IN STUDYING SUBJECTS RELATIVE TO THE FLIGHT COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE, IT IS DESIRABLE THAT EACH COMMUNICATOR HAVE HIS OWN COPY OF THE PHOTOGRAPHED STUDY OUTLINE. ALTHOUGH THIS OUTLINE IS ORIGINALLY FURNISHED IN SINGLE COPY TO EACH STATION, WASHINGTON HAS NOW SUPPLIED A SUFFICIENT QUANTITY TO ENABLE US TO PROVIDE INDIVIDUAL COPIES FOR EACH OF OUR PERSONNEL. IT IS BELIEVED THAT A COMPLETE SET OF TEXT BOOKS FOR EACH COMMUNICATOR WOULD ALSO BE DESIRABLE, BUT WE ARE UNABLE TO OBTAIN SUFFICIENT COPIES AT THE PRESENT TIME TO EFFECT SUCH DISTRIBUTION. HOWEVER, A LIMITED NUMBER OF ADDITIONAL TEXTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED AND WILL BE PHOTODUPLICATED AMONG FIELD STATIONS ON THE BASIS OF PERSONNEL COMPLMENTS. DISTRIBUTION OF ADDITIONAL MANUALS AND STUDY OUTLINES IS EXPECTED IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

IN ASSEMBLING THE STUDY MODEL AIR NAVIGATION COMPUTER, IT HAS BEEN FOUND POSSIBLE TO OBTAIN MORE RIGID MOUNTING BY GLUING THE COMPASS ROSE AND THE "M" SCALE TO OPPOSITE SIDES OF A 1/4" PLAT CARDBOARD. TO PROTECT THE COMPUTER FROM DAMAGE WHEN NOT IN USE, AN ENVELOPE CUT TO SIZE FROM HEAVY PAPER IS SUGGESTED.
