DO YOU HAVE TEN DOLLARS IN YOUR POCKET? YOU HAVE PAID YOUR RENT AND YOUR UTILITY BILLS - YOU ARE ADEQUATELY CLOTHED - BUT THAT EXTRA TEN DOLLARS -WHAT ARE YOU GOING TO GO WITH IT? WELL, THERE'S D---- LITTLE YOU CAN DO WITH TEN DOLLARS THESE DAYS. MAY? INFLATION IS HERE! SALARIES, ON THE WHOLE, ARE HIGH - AND FEORLE BUY AND BUY AND BUY. THE MORE WE BUY, AND PAY THE HIGH PRICES ASKED. THE MORE WE POOST INPLATION. DAY BY DAY WE ARE TAKING FIGURATIVE CUTS IN SALARY, LIMITING OUR CHANCES FOR A SECURE FIMANCIAL FUTURE AND LENGTHENING THE DURATIC OF THE WAR SIMPLY BY USING SOME OF THAT SURPLUS MONEY FOR PURCHASING SOMETHING WE COULD JUST AS WELL DO STITHOUT.

INFLATION IS NOT STATIC. IT IS A CONDITION GROUGHT ABOUT BY THE INDIVIDUAL AND CONSERTED ACTION OF PEOPLE - AND IT CAN BE CONTROLLED AND REDUCED BY THE SAME MEANS. YOU ARE ONLY ONE PERSON AMONG MILLIONS. YOU CAN'T HELP BUT FEEL THAT ANYTHING DONE BY THE LITTLE "MOLECULE" THAT IS YOU . HAS VERY LITTLE EFFECT ON THE WHOLE PICTURE. BUT IT DOES - IF EVERYONE FELT UTIMPORTANT AND INSEFECTUAL IN THE LARGER SCHEME - WE WOULD STON FIND OURCELVES UNABLE TO PURCHASE THE BARE MECESSITIES OF LIFE WITH OUR NOW FAIRLY ADEQUATE SALARIES - WE WOULD LOSE THE WAR - AND CHAOS BEYOND IMAGINATION WOULD REQUET.

EACH OF US - AND ALL OF US - HAVE A PERSONAL OBLIGHTION TO OUR FUTURE AND TO THE FUTURE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. IT IS INVIGORATING TO KNOW THAT NO ACTION ON OUR PART - NO MATTER HOW SMALL AND APPARENTLY INSIGNIFICANT - BUT HAS ITS DEFINITE EFFECT ON PRESENT CONDITIONS.

THE OPPORTUNITY IS ALWAYS WITH US - BUT SOMETIMES IT MUST BE AROUGHT TO OUR ATTENTION. IT IS NOT EASY TO HOLD SUSTAINED ENTHUSIASM OVER A LONG PERIOD OF TIME - BUT WE MUST NOT LET DOWN.

THE FOURTH WAR LOAN DRIVE IS IMMINENT. WE ARE ASKED TO INVEST 35% OF OUR SALARIES IN WAR BONDS FOR THE FERIOD JANUARY 18 TO FEBRUARY 15. 1944. IF YOU ARE ALREADY ALLOTTING, FOR INSTANCE, 15% OF YOUR SALARY FOR PURCHASE OF BONDS, THEN AN ADDITIONAL 20% ONLY IS EXFECTED. CUR QUOTA IS \$75.508.11 FOR THE EIGHTH REGION. IT IS GOING TO BE A TOUGH GOAL TO REACH. THERE IS ONE WAY ONLY TO DO IT. WHEN YOU GET YOUR NEXT PAY CHECK SET ASIDE 35% OF IT AND BUY BONDS. IT MAY PINCH - PERHAPS THERE ARE THINGS YOU FEEL YOU REALLY NEED - BUT DO WITHOUT THEM AT LEAST UNTIL AFTER THE DRIVE. YOU CAN ALWAYS GET ALONG SOMEHOW - AND IT IS ONLY THROUGH SACRIFICE THAT WE CAN EVENTUALLY BRING ABOUT THAT STATE FOR WHICH WE ARE ALL STRIVING.

MANY OF US ARE SACRIFICING - BUT THE CARELESS ACTIONS OF THE THOUGHTLESS OR SELFISH ARE MAKING IT TOUGH FOR THOSE WHO ARE GIVING IT ALL THEY VE GOT.

WE EXCEEDED OUR QUOTA FOR THE THIRD WAR LOAM DRIVE - BUT PART OF THE SUCCESS OF THAT DRIVE WAS DUE TO THE LARGE AMOUNTS INVESTED BY COMPASATIVELY FEW OF THE CIVIL AERONAUTICS ADMINISTRATION PERSONNEL. IF EACH OF US INVESTS SOMETHING WE WILL REACH OUR GOAL - NOT ONLY THE GOAL OF MAKING OUR QUOTA IN THE FOURTH WAR LOWN DRIVE, BUT THAT LARGER WAS BROADER GOAL OF BRINGING ACAIN INTO OUR LIVES THE PEACE, SECURITY, AND DEMOCRACY WHICH IS OUR RIGHT.

THE NEXT FEW MEEKS WILL BRING A CONSIDERABLE NUMBER OF NEW COMMUNICATIONS PERSONNEL TO THE TIGHTH REGION. THIS PERSONNEL, WHICH WILL CONSIST OF BOTH GRADUATES OF THE SCATTLE TRAINING CENTER AND VOLUNTEERS FROM THE UNITED STATES, WILL BE USED TO AUGMENT PRESENT STATION COMPLEMENTS AND TO IMPLEMENT THE CIRCUIT EXPANSION PROGRAM. FOR THE MAJORITY OF THESE COMMUNICATORS, ALASKA WILL BE A NEW EXPERIENCE; ALSO, THE GREATER PART OF THEM ARE EMBARKING UPOM A NEW CAREER, AND WHETHER OR NOT THEY ARE FAVORABLY IMPRESSED WITH THE COUNTRY AND SCOOKE ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT THEIR WORK, WILL DEPEND TO A LARGE EXTENT ON THE IMPRESSION THEY GAIN FROM THEIR ASSOCIATIONS WITH YOU — THEIR FELLOW WORKERS.

THEREFORE, IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE ASSIGNMENT OF NEW PERSONNEL WILL ANSWER A TWO-FOLD PURPOSE.

IT IS REALIZED THAT "ON THE JOB TRAINING" OF NEW AIRCRAFT COMMUNICATOR PERSONNEL IS A TREMENDOUS TASK AND ONE THAT REQUIRES THE EXPENDITURE OF CONSIDERABLE TIME AND PATIENCE BY OTHER STATION PERSONNEL. HOWEVER, IT IS FIRMLY BELIEVED THAT IT IS TIME WELL SPENT. WITH YOU RESTS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF WHETHER OR NOT THE NEW EMPLOYEE TURNS OUT TO BE AN EFFICIENT COMMUNICATOR NO A CREDIT TO YOU, HIS INSTRUCTOR, AND OUR ORGANIZATION, OR JUST ANOTHER "FAIR COMMUNICATOR."

ON NOVEMBER 27TH NC711Y RAN OUT OF GAS AND LANDED NEAR LOUIGE AT THE LOWER END OF ILLIAMNA LAKE. TEM MINUTES LATER STEWART HAD ANOTHER ATRICART WHICH WAS AT ILLIAMNA LOADING UP WITH GAS FOR THE STR.NDED PLANE. AS THIS PLANE WAS TAXIHING OUT FOR TAKEOFF, NC711Y ADVISED GAS COULD BE OBTAINED NEARBY. STEWART HIT THE MIKE AND RECALLED THE SUPPLY PLANE BEFORE IT LEFT THE GROUND. LATER, WEATHER INFORMATION WAS TURNISHED NC711Y AND IT PROCEEDED TO NAMNEK.

ON DECEMBER 18th, NC451N WAS FORCED DOWN ING THEREFROM: "SERVICE OF THIS NATIONAL ABOUT 20 MILES SOUTHWEST OF LLIAMNA LAKE AND EXEMPLIFIES THE AIM OF THIS ORGANIZATION THE AIRCRAFT BADLY DAMAGED. FORTUNATELY THE OF ALL POSSIBLE ASSISTANCE TO AIRMEN."

RADIO EQUIPMENT REMAINED OPERATIVE AND THE PILOT CONTACTED LIAMNA RADIO. STEWART WENT INTO HIGH GEAR AND NOT ONLY ARRANCED DISPATCH OF A RESCUE PLANE FROM MAKNEK, BUT ALSO CONTACTED PASSING AIRCRAFT AND ACTED AS LIAISON BETWEEN SAID AIRCRAFT, THE DISABLED PLANE, AND NAMNEK RADIO TO SUCH GOOD PURPOSE THAT THE POSITION OF NCU51N WAS QUICKLY LOCATED AND RESCUING AIRCRAFT PICKED UP THE PILOT AND PASSENGER. THIS WITHIN 5 HOURS OF THE TIME OF THE CRASH.

THE FACTS SPEAK FOR THEMSELVES. THE RESIDNAL OFFICE HAS BEEN PLEASED TO ISSUE OFFICIAL LETTERS OF COMMENDATION TO ACAC STEWART; AND QUOTING THEREFROM: "SERVICE OF THIS NATURE WELL EXEMPLIFIES THE AIM OF THIS ORGANIZATION TO BE OF ALL POSSIBLE ASSISTANCE TO AIRMEN."

THE ANCHORAGE AIRWAY TRAFFIC CONTROL CENTER WAS PLACED IN OPERATION DECEMBER 3, 1913, AND ALREADY WE ARE ENJOYING OUR SECOND YEAR OF 1914. 
