**DOT ANNOUNCES PLANS TO AWARD
\$987 MILLION IN FEDERAL TRANSIT
GRANTS FOR SECOND QUARTER OF FY 1993**

The Department of Transportation's Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has announced it intends to award \$987 million in grants to fund local public transit projects, aid transportation in rural areas and improve transit services for elderly passengers and those with disabilities.

According to FTA Administrator Brian W. Clymer, "These FTA formula grants covering 43 states and Puerto Rico will be used for purposes as diverse as operating costs, vehicle acquisition, construction and rehabilitation, planning studies, computer equipment and real estate acquisition."

The largest grant on the list is for \$211 million to the New Jersey Transit Corp. In addition to operating funds, it includes money for rail infrastructure improvements and replacement buses.
