UMTA ANNOUNCES 147 GRANTS  
TOTALING \$184 MILLION

Brian W. Clymer, administrator of the Urban Mass Transportation Administration, today announced that during the fourth quarter of FY 1990, 147 grants totaling \$184 million were awarded to 35 states, Puerto Rico and American Samoa.

"These projects are indicative of the continuing federal interest in mass transit as outlined in the National Transportation Policy," Clymer said. "The funds, which will be used for transit in both rural and urban areas, and for providing elderly and disabled Americans with reliable transportation, will help meet important mobility needs in communities of all sizes."

The National Transportation Policy is a comprehensive strategy to maintain, modernize and expand the nation's infrastructure and advance transportation into the 21st century.

The 147 grants will be used for the purchase and rehabilitation of mass transit vehicles; the planning and engineering of transit projects; operating assistance; and the improvement of transit accessibility for disabled passengers. Some of the funds will be used in programs to help increase the participation of minority and disadvantaged firms in public transportation, and to promote the use of non-petroleum energy sources for vehicles and facilities.
