UMTA ANNOUNCES \$450 MILLION IN MASS TRANSIT ASSISTANCE

The Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) has awarded over 270 grants totalling approximately \$450 million in federal transit funds for projects in 49 states, Secretary of Transportation Samuel K. Skinner announced today.

Skinner said, "These grants will fund a wide range of transit activities including vehicle acquisition, construction and rehabilitation, operating assistance and planning."

UMTA uses a special grants management system to expedite actual delivery of funds to transit agencies, thus ensuring a predictable flow of funding to recipients.

The grants awarded for the third quarter of Fiscal Year 1989 will fund a variety of transit projects, including the purchase of buses and related support equipment, maintenance and support facilities, rail modernization projects, bus passenger shelters, as well as improvements in communications and computer equipment.

A complete listing of the grants by state is attached.
