MASS TRANSIT GRANTS AWARDED TO LOCAL TRANSIT AUTHORITIES AND CITIES

The U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) today announced its intent to approve \$741,763,241 in capital, planning and operating formula grants for public transit activities nationwide.

Under the UMTA quarterly grant review and approval process, applicants who submit complete applications that meet the minimum statutory requirements can expect a grant award within 90 days. The next block of grants will be announced in September 1986.

In announcing the grants, UMTA Administrator Ralph L. Stanley said, "UMTA's quarterly review process provides our grantees with a predictable delivery system for federal assistance. If a local transit operator prepares his capital and operating budget plan and submits a completed application during one of the scheduled review quarters, he'll know to the day when to expect a grant award."
