MASS TRANSIT GRANTS AWARDED TO LOCAL TRANSIT AUTHORITIES AND CITIES

The U.S. Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) today announced its intent to approve more than a half-billion dollars in capital, planning and operating formula grants for public transit activities nationwide.

The announcement is UMTA's second under a new grants release process. Earlier UMTA announced \$11,848,856 in state administered transit grants to 13 states for public transportation projects in non-urbanized areas and transportation assistance for elderly and handicapped persons.

In announcing these grants, Urban Mass Transportation Administrator Ralph L. Stanley said, "UMTA is committed to improving its grants processing by expediting the review and approval of state administered and formula grants. When President Reagan signed the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of 1982 (STAA) into law, he affirmed this nation's commitment to an effective mass transit system. Transportation Secretary Elizabeth Hanford Dole and I believe the new procedures will provide a more predictable delivery system for Federal transit assistance."

As a part of the new quarterly grant review and approval process, applicants who submit complete applications which meet the minimum statutory requirements can expect a grant award within 90 days. The process is expected to expedite the flow of funds to finance local transit operations and capital projects. The next block of grants will be announced on June 30.

"If a local transit operator prepares his capital and operating budget plan and submits a completed application during one of the scheduled review quarters, he'll know to the day when to expect a grant award. This should virtually eliminate local cash flow problems caused by delayed grants," Stanley said.
