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\$2.4 BILLION IN UMTA FORMULA FUNDS ANNOUNCED

The apportionment of more than \$2.4 billion in federal mass transit funds to the Nation's cities and states for fiscal year 1985 was announced today by the Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA).

Determined by a formula based on population, population density and transit service factors, these apportionments ultimately result in federal grants to support local transit systems for capital and operating assistance. The full amount of the apportionment may be used for capital projects. Approximately \$870 million is available for operating assistance. In addition to its formula grant program, UMTA also provides capital assistance through its \$1.1 billion discretionary program.

For urbanized areas over 200,000 population, the formula funds are apportioned directly. Funds for urbanized areas less than 200,000 and for rural areas are apportioned to the state governors.

Commenting on today's announcement UMTA Administrator Ralph L. Stanley said, "We are pleased to provide these apportionments early in the fiscal year because we know how important the figures are to local mass transportation operators in planning their programs."
