UMTA WORKSHOPS FOR MINORITY EDUCATORS

Atlanta University and North Carolina A&T University have been selected to host the Urban Mass Transportation Administration's (UMTA) summer workshop program for faculty members from minority colleges.

The workshop program offers training in transportation issues and is intended to assist faculty members from minority institutions in competing for transportation research grants. UMTA considers this program to be an investment that will pay dividends as these colleges contribute to the transportation industry in research and training.

The summer program will last six weeks, from June 18 to July 27, 1984, and will include sessions on urban transportation at Atlanta University and sessions on non-urban transportation at North Carolina A&T in Greensboro, North Carolina.

UMTA Administrator Ralph L. Stanley commented, "Through this program, we are responding to the Administration's pledge to increase participation of historically black colleges in federally funded programs." UMTA will contribute \$200,000 to sponsor this year's session.
