DELLIBOVI APPOINTED UMTA DEPUTY ADMINISTRATOR

Administrator Ralph L. Stanley has announced the appointment of Alfred A. DelliBovi of New York as Deputy Administrator of the Department of Transportation's Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA).

DelliBovi since 1981 has served as UMTA's Regional Administrator for Connecticut, New Jersey, New York and the Virgin Islands.

"Al DelliBovi has had great experience in managing a variety of UMTA projects, from new light rail systems, as well as bus systems of all sizes in his two years as a Regional Administrator," Administrator Stanley said. "His strong background in State and local government plus his administration of the Nation's most transit intensive region make him well-suited for the position of UMTA Deputy Administrator."

DelliBovi, 38, was a member of the New York State Assembly from New York City from 1971-1978. A graduate of Fordham College, he also holds a Master of Public Administration degree from the City of University of New York.
