UMTA ANNOUNCES TRANSIT ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS

Urban Mass Transportation Administrator Arthur E. Teele, Jr., has announced the appointment of the 15 members of a Reporting System Advisory Committee.

The committee will investigate and determine the usefulness of financial and operating data in improving transit system performance. UMTA is required by law to prescribe uniform accounting systems for local transit authorities.

"This advisory function is vital to the success of our continuing efforts to improve transit services at a cost we can afford," Teele said.

J. Fred Coldren, City Manager of Cape May, New Jersey, will serve as Chairman of the Committee, which includes a cross-section of executives in the public transit industry, local government, organized labor, academia and private industry.
