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DOT RELEASES ADDITIONAL
1983 MASS TRANSIT APPORTIONMENT

Secretary of Transportation Elizabeth Hanford Dole today announced the apportionment of \$711.8 million in transit assistance for the current fiscal year.

Today's apportionment of funds supplements information published in the Federal Register on January 24, 1983. That notice included preliminary apportionments from the Mass Transit Account of the Highway Trust Fund for transit capital projects totaling 65 percent of the total funds authorized for this program in fiscal year 1983.

Today's action apportions the remainder of authorized funds to non-urbanized areas and urbanized areas under 200,000 population. Urbanized areas over 200,000 population will receive 90.3 percent of the authorized funds. The remaining 9.7 percent is being reserved to allow for adjustments in the final apportionment based upon an analysis of data submitted by transit operators.

The final apportionment will be published no later than July 1, 1983.

Apportionment tables are attached. Apportionments to areas of over 200,000 population are made directly to the urbanized areas. Apportionments to areas between 50,000 to 200,000 population are made directly to the governor.

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(Total funds apportioned are 90.3 percent of the FY 1983 level for urbanized areas over 200,000 population, 100 percent for both urbanized areas under 200,000 and non-urbanized areas)
