TRANSIT BIBLIOGRAPHY AVAILABLE

The availability of a major reference work in the field of transportation was announced today by the Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) with publication of the <u>Urban Mass Transportation</u>
Abstracts Cumulative Bibliography 1974—1980.

The Bibliography, containing more than 7,000 abstracts, and its companion Index of subjects, containing some 3,400 listings, were developed by the Transportation Research Board. The reference work, funded by UMTA, represents a significant addition to the resource of literature on urban transportation.

The listings' were derived from the Urban Mass Transportation Research Information Service (UMTRIS), an automated data system which contains information on transit planning, operations, management and finance.
