DEPUTY ASSOCIATE ADMINISTRATOR FOR BUDGET-POLICY NAMED IN UMTA

Washington -- The appointment of Lawrence L. Schulman as Deputy Associate Administrator for Budget and Policy of the Urban Mass Transportation Administration was announced by UMTA Administrator Arthur E. Teele, Jr.

The appointment marks a promotion to the Senior Executive Service for Schulman, who has been serving since 1975 as Director of the Office of Policy and Development.

In announcing the appointment, Teele said Schulman "exemplifies the highest standards of career public service, and I am delighted to be able to recognize his outstanding contributions this way."

Schulman has received the Department of Transportation's Outstanding and Superior service awards and special recognition for his service in mass transportation development. He is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, Institute of Traffic Engineers, Transportation Research, and Chi Epsilon.

Schulman began his Federal service in 1964 as a planner for the Federal Highway Administration's Urban Planning Division. He came to UMTA in 1971 as Chief Transportation Planner and assumed progressively responsible positions within the agency.

He received a Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering from City University in New York in 1963. He earned a Master's degree in Transportation Planning from Purdue University in 1964. Mr. Schulman and his wife, Carol, reside in Potomac, Md., with their three children -- Donna, 15, Bruce, 12, and Cindy, 10.
