DOT AWARDS GRANT TO HOWARD UNIVERSITY FOR MINORITY FACULTY WORKSHOP

Urban Mass Transportation Administrator Arthur E. Teele, Jr., today announced a \$167,435 grant to Howard University, Washington, D.C. The grant will assist the university in conducting a summer workshop in transportation-related studies for faculty members of predominantly minority colleges and universities.

The six-week workshop will be held from June 21 to July 30 at Howard's Institute for Urban Affairs and Research. It will provide training in transportation research, planning and management and computer utilization for 15 faculty members. It is designed to enhance the ability of the faculty to conduct research on contemporary transit problems, and to reinforce their abilities to propose a wide range of research and development projects.

UMTA sponsored transit oriented summer workshops for faculty members of predominantly minority institutions in 1980 and 1981 at State University of New York at Buffalo.
