DOT APPOINTS REGIONAL
UMTA REPRESENTATIVE

The Department of Transportation today announced the appointment of Alfred A. DelliBovi as Regional Administrator of the Urban Mass Transportation Administration, responsible for overseeing federal mass transit assistance programs in Connecticut, New Jersey, New York and Puerto Rico.

"We are delighted to have Al DelliBovi join the Reagan Administration's team," UMTA Administrator Arthur E. Teele, Jr., said. "As the Administration turns its efforts toward the rebuilding of our nation's older mass transit systems, his experience and background will insure that the objectives of our program are carried out effectively."

DelliBovi will be headquartered in his native New York City. He is a graduate of Fordham College and holds a Master of Public Administration Degree from the City University of New York.

A member of the New York State Assembly for seven years, he was Chairman of the Assembly's Task Force on Mass Transportation. Most recently, he has been Director of New York City Affairs for the Minority Leader of the State Assembly.

DelliBovi is thirty-five years old, is married and has one son.
