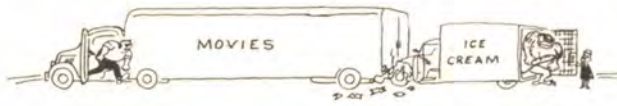

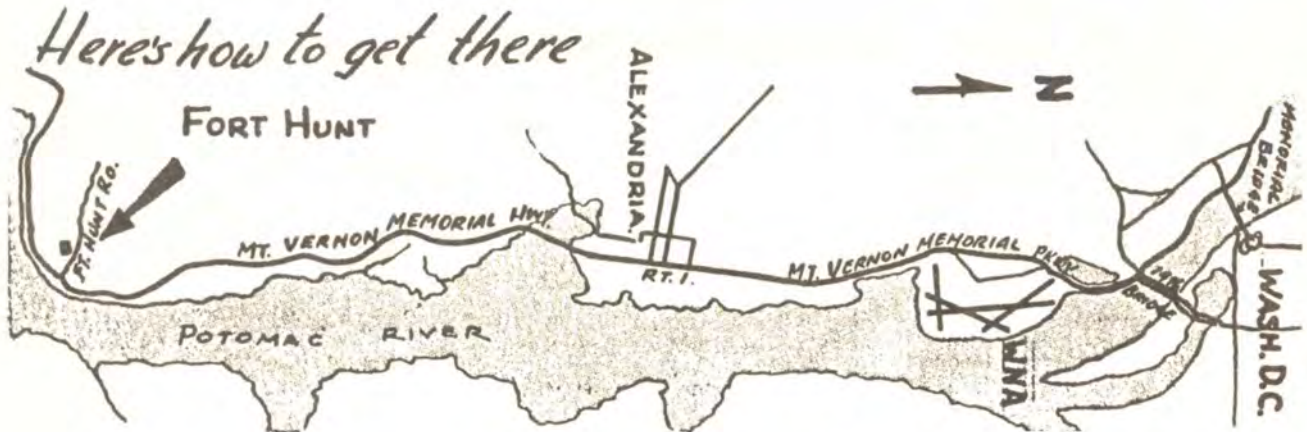

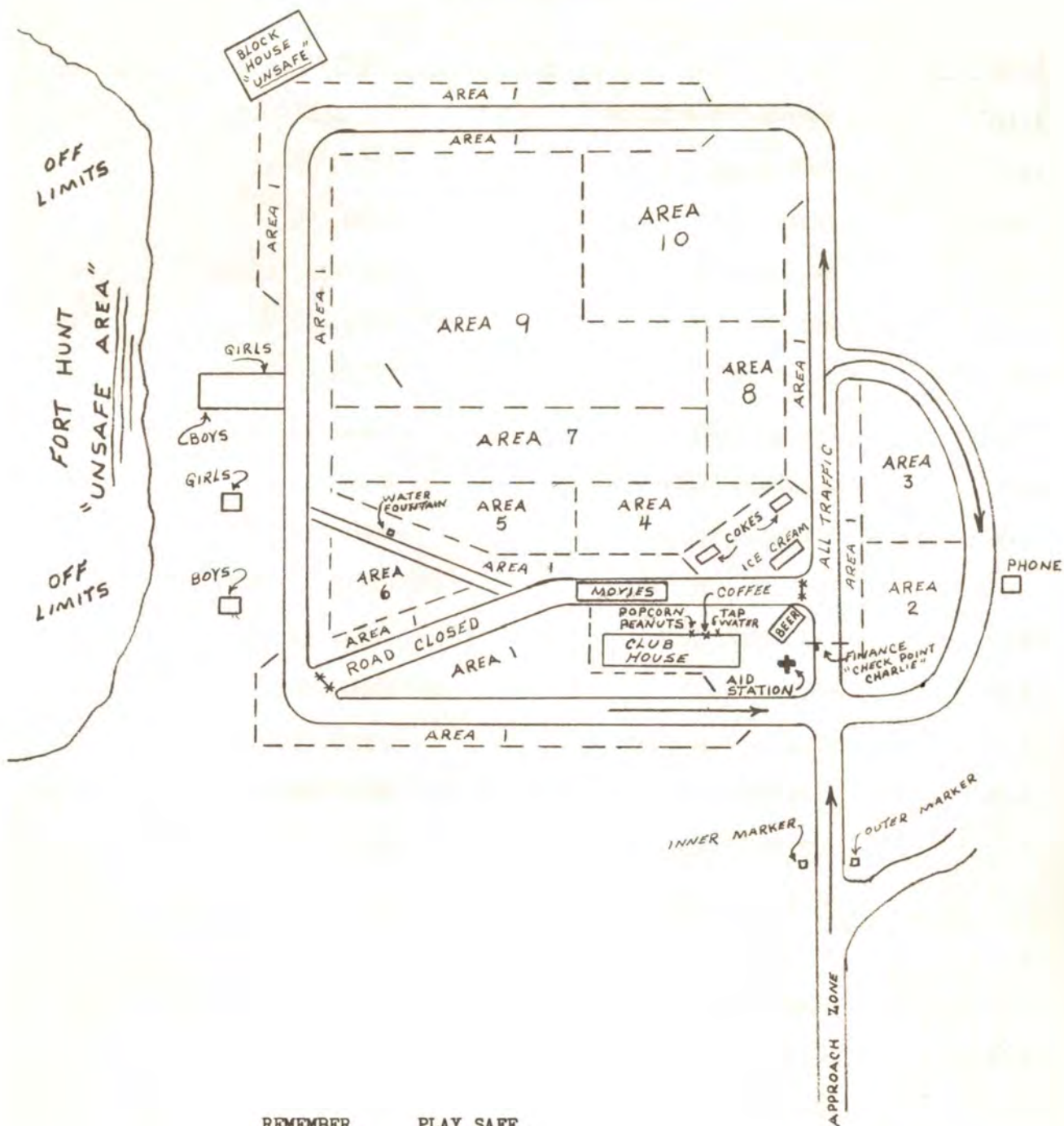


NATIONAL CAPITAL PARKS
FORT HUNT, VA.
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The area must be vacated promptly at dark.
2. This permit is granted with the understanding that the group will assume complete responsibility for the restoration of any damaged Government property and for the clean-up of the area and Club House.
3. Permittee will save the United States harmless from any claim or liability resulting from the use of the area; will maintain good order, and will comply with any instructions from the U. S. Park Police or other official representatives of this Service.
4. No dog or cat, unless caged or on a leash not more than six feet long and entirely under control, shall be taken or exercised in the picnic area.
5. No contributions shall be solicited or accepted and no sales shall be made without the specific authorization of this office.
6. Gambling in any form, whether for merchandise or otherwise, is prohibited.
7. Public address systems or radios shall not be operated to the annoyance of other persons.
8. The State law prohibiting the serving of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age must be observed.

The Federal Aviation Agency has enjoyed a good reputation during past picnics at Fort Hunt, Virginia. Let's ALL cooperate to maintain this reputation.

NOTES OF INTEREST

This year your FA Club is looking forward to another successful picnic and there is reason to believe it will be the best one yet.

Tickets will be collected at the Park entrance and a "Brand" (of washable dye) placed on the back of one hand of every person. This is to protect your interests from poachers who have invaded this event in the past. Vendors will refuse to serve anyone who does not show a "Brand" upon request.

Pony and train rides will begin at 12 O'Clock and operate until 5 P.M.

Movies will be shown in a trailer because the club house has been condemned and closed.

Rest rooms will be provided, in the form of a mobile comfort station, by the U. S. Park Service.

Refreshments served will be soda, ice cream, milk, coffee, peanuts, popcorn, and beer. Please bring your own pitcher for beer.

The schedule of events is designed to promote maximum entertainment, participation, and safety to all in attendance. We regret some activities are limited in time and scope; however, we are sure each member of our Agency is willing to share his pleasure with the children, guests, and fellow employees.

The Park Service has granted permission to use the two ball diamonds beyond Area 10 if they are not in use; however, they must be surrendered if the little league team has a game scheduled. Maximum effort will be made to provide softball games and areas for all groups desiring to play.

SAFETY NOTES

The old FORT is considered a danger area and is clearly marked with "NO TRESPASSING" signs. The area was inspected and found to be infested with poison ivy, wasps, spiders, and a host of insects and litter. The support structures in many areas are decayed and subject to collapse at any time.

The Block House adjacent to Area 9 is not considered sanitary and has a broken door that cannot be secured. At the time of inspection several items were stored in the building in such a manner as to render them dangerous to curious children. It is requested that we refrain from entering these areas to make our event a safe and pleasant one.
