

#### LATEST ON THE "FREEZE"

One major change of interest to DOT employees in regard to the recent freeze on promotions is that promotions resulting from reclassifications are now permitted. However, management must assure itself that raising the level of the position is essential to the mission of the organization and will result in more economical and efficient attainment of program objectives. In addition, there must be evidence that the employee will actually perform at the higher grade level before upgradings resulting from reclassifications and career progressions can be effected.

Another minor change is that although within-grade increases and quality step increases are still frozen, cash awards based on superior performance can be made under the Incentive Awards Program.

#### IMPROVEMENT OF HOUSEKEEPING HABITS

With the opening of the cafeteria in the Headquarters Building, a tour of the building discloses that the careless housekeeping habits of a few employees must be improved if attractive facilities are to be enjoyed by all.

Certain employees are placing partially filled containers of liquids in waste baskets and carrying containers of beverages and food from the cafeteria to their work stations without lids. The carpet and wall staining that results from spillage is contributing to an intolerably unsightly condition.

Employees are requested to exercise care in transporting food.
