BLOOD DONOR PROGRAM - GOOD NEWS!!

The final and official Red Cross figures for the year ending June 30, 1972, show that for the first time ever, DOT has reached its yearly quota! CONGRATULATIONS! The total DOT quota was set at 1604 pints; 1659 pints were donated. This means that $\underline{\text{all}}$ DOT Washington Headquarters employees (and their immediate families) $\underline{\text{are}}$ covered for this year should they require blood transfusion.
