CENTRALIZED GRAPHICS SERVICE FOR DOT WASHINGTON HEADQUARTERS

Graphics service in the Washington Headquarters was consolidated under the Working Capital Fund system in the Office of the Secretary, Office of Administrative Operations, effective July 2, 1972. This centralized function will be performed by the Graphics Branch, TAD-486, under the Publishing and Graphics Division. The Chief of the Graphics Branch will be located in the DOT Headquarters Building in Room 3411, where complete graphics service will be available. A similar facility will be maintained in Building FOB 10A. The relocation to Room 3411 of the former FHWA, Coast Guard, and NHTSA facilities will be effected when inventories and space planning is completed. This is expected to take three to four weeks. In the interim, graphics services will be obtained by the same procedures and at the same locations as in the past. A DOT directive describing the service and establishing policy, standards, and revised procedures is in process and will be issued at the time the relocation of this facility to Room 3411.

HOT COPY SERVICE

Customers are reminded that non-priority copy work may be left with the Hot Copy room attendant to be run off as time permits. The attendant can usually give you an estimated time for pick-up, or you can request that the work be returned to you by mail. Use of this practice for non-urgent work can conserve valuable secretarial time.
