## NEW NAME FOR THE DOT BUILDING AT BUZZARD POINT!

Secretary Brinegar has announced plans to award \$150 for the best suggestion for an official name for the DOT Buzzard Point facility. The contest is open to all employees of Washington Headquarters elements of DOT.

The ground rules are as follows. Each employee may submit one entry. The suggested name must:

- a. reflect dignity;
- b. be short and succinct;
- c. not be copyrighted;
- d. be in keeping with the DOT mission; and,
- e. not be the name of a current DOT employee.

The suggestion form must contain the DOT office and routing symbol of the suggestor, and the suggested name clearly printed. Suggestions must be received in the Office of Personnel and Training, Attention: TAD-13, by c.o.b. November 30, 1973.

The selected entry may or may not be adopted verbatim. The winning entry will be selected by a panel of top ranking DOT officials, including the Secretary. A tear-out entry form is printed below.
