NOTICE OF CHANGE IN TRAFFIC ROUTING

The D. C. Department of Highways and Traffic has determined that 6th and 7th Streets be made one-way between Independence Avenue and E Street. Effective this weekend 7th will be one-way south and 6th one-way north. The change will affect the following:

- 1. The traffic flow to and from FOB-10A garage;
- 2. Traffic flow to and from the DOT Headquarters Building;
- 3. The shuttle bus southbound and the DOT Headquarters bus stop.

The new bus stop location for the southbound route will be at the corner of 6th and E adjacent to St. Dominic's Church, instead of opposite School Street on 6th. The northbound bus stop will remain the same (the corner of 6th and School Streets).

The new routing on 7th Street will take the busses directly through the construction area. This may cause some deterioration in service, but every effort will be made to adhere to present schedules.

Changes to METRO bus routes $\underline{\text{have not yet been determined}}$, but we anticipate the following:

- 1. Busses which presently come south on 6th Street will come south on 7th Street and that busses which presently come north on 7th Street will proceed over E Street and turn north on 6th.
- Busses leaving Southwest Mall and presently turning left on 7th Street will turn left on 6th. The stop nearest the DOT Headquarters Building will be on 6th Street at the railroad bridge.

When METRO route changes are finally determined, the information will be widely disseminated.
