METRO CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS IN VICINITY OF DOT HEADQUARTERS BUILDING

DOT WAREHOUSE ACTIVITY

- Requests for Forms and Publications: All requests for forms and publications should be made in writing and sent to the DOT Warehouse, TAD-443.1. In emergency situations only, telephone requests may be made to the Facilities Management Branch, TAD-443, extension 69654.
- Receipt and/or Inspection of Shipments: Receipt and inspection of furniture and equipment at the DOT Warehouse is the responsibility of the administrations' property custodians. Property custodians should contact their Building Manager, who in turn will coordinate inspection requests with the Warehouse Manager.

Admittance to Warehouse: Under no circumstances will admittance to the DOT Warehouse be granted without the express prior approval of the Warehouse Manager or one of his Section Chiefs (or Chief of the Shipping and Receiving Section??).
