The Department of Transportation today proposed two new Federal standards that would establish safety performance requirements for tires and rims used on motor vehicles other than passenger cars.

The requirements of the proposed rules, developed by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, would apply to new pneumatic tires and rims for use on multi-purpose passenger vehicles, trucks, buses, trailers, and motorcycles.

Their purpose would be to ensure that vehicles other than passenger cars are equipped with tires and rims of adequate size and strength to provide safe operational performance. Similar standards for tires and rims for passenger cars are already in effect.

The proposed rule for tires would set performance, marking, and dimensional requirements, and require information to be marked on the tires sufficient for their proper selection and use.

The proposed standard on rims would require each vehicle to which the standard applies to be equipped with tires that meet the requirements of Federal standards, and with rims that are

suitable for use with those tires. It would also establish performance and marking requirements for rims, including a requirement that a rim retain a deflated tire at 60 miles per hour, followed by a controlled stop of the vehicle.

The proposal on tires would be effective on September 1, 1972 and the proposal on rims on January 1, 1973.

Interested persons are invited to submit data, views, or arguments on the proposed rules by the close of business on November 2, 1971.

Douglas W. Toms, Administrator of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, has reaffirmed a Department of Transportation goal to drastically cut the nation's traffic toll. "By 1980, we hope to reduce motor vehicle fatalities on the nation's roads and highways by about 50 per cent, or half of the current annual deaths of 55,000," said Toms, after having been sworn in by Secretary of Transportation John A. Volpe on July 22.

Toms, who had been Acting Administrator, is responsible for all aspects of motor vehicle safety standards, applicable to new cars, trucks and motorcycles, and a wide range of federally-assisted State highway safety programs. The three major priorities of his administration are crash survivability, alcohol countermeasures, and the development of a number of experimental safety vehicles.

Toms, who is 40, was appointed in December 1969 as Director of the National Highway Safety Bureau, the predecessor of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Before joining the Federal Government, Mr. Toms was Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles for the State of Washington. He taught extensively at the California State College of Los Angeles, California, at Central Michigan University, and at Michigan State University.

Toms is a past president of the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators. In 1966, he was named as one of the three outstanding young men in the State of Washington.

Over 1 1/2 million minibikes, most of them operated by children 10 to 14 years old, will be in use in the U.S. by the end of this year. An estimated 500,000 of these will be purchased this year.

In a warning to parents issued today, the Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration notes in a public advisory that with the minibike's growing popularity, there will come a parallel growth in fatal crashes as these small, two-wheeled, usually unlicensed vehicles take to the streets and roadways.

In issuing the advisory, Safety Administrator Doug Toms said, "more and more young children are going to be killed unless they and their parents recognize the dangers involved in the use of minibikes. Our advisory attempts to make clear those dangers."

The Traffic Safety Administration says it has no authority to regulate vehicles which are intended solely for off-road use, and that the minibike problem is a matter for State regulation and enforcement. However, the advisory points out the clear responsibility

of parents in preventing the inevitable tragedies that may result when minibikes are turned over to drivers as young as 7, 8, or 10 years old.

The Safety Administration believes that most minibike fatalities occur in collisions with other vehicles, and that while off-street riding under parental supervision can be a safe and popular recreation, the minibike becomes a high-risk vehicle on sidewalks and roadways. The Agency categorically opposes all use of minibikes on sidewalks or streets.

In an effort to convince parents that the risk is a real one, the advisory cites several characteristics which make minibikes unsuitable for highway use. It says they are noted for poor handling characteristics because of their short wheelbase and small tires. Minibike engines fail to provide acceleration and speed capabilities that are entirely suitable to the highway. Their brakes are often inadequate, and the vehicles are difficult to spot by other drivers because of their small size and low profile.

Parents are further warned against the assumption that family insurance coverage automatically extends to minibikes. While a typical homeowner's policy may provide public liability coverage, it is not likely that it covers damage sustained by others in a minibike accident. And as to the unlicensed minibiker on the highway, family auto insurance policies give no protection at all.

Rules for safe minibike operation are also outlined by the advisory. The first and most important rule of use should forbid any travel on streets or sidewalks. To protect against the injuries which occur most often, those to the rider's head, helmets should be mandatory riding equipment. Sturdy clothing and shoes are recommended to reduce injuries from falling.

In addition to checking closely into the additional insurance protection that may be necessary to protect the young riders, parents should make sure that off-street areas are available for minibike use. Otherwise, the combination of the minibike and public thoroughfares invites tragedy.

Minibikes, it is also noted, are designed for only one rider, and the chances for an accident increase significantly when a passenger is carried. Finally, the Traffic Safety Administration advises that many private properties are already closed to minibike use. Since

excessive noise is a major nuisance causing property owners to close their land to minibike use, parents are urged to form riding clubs, to find suitable areas for safe and legal riding.

For parents unsure of what is and is not a minibike, the advisory notes that while licensing requirements may vary from State to State, the Motorcycle Industry Council recently supplied the following definition.

Lacking any nationally accepted criteria or a legal definition in a given locality, a two wheel vehicle is a minibike, says the Council, if it has wheel rims of less than 10 inches in diameter, or a hub-to-hub wheelbase of less than 40 inches, or an engine rated at less than 45 c.c., and/or a seat height of less than 25 inches from the ground.

The Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and Federal Highway Administration jointly announced today that States will be provided with \$75 million in Federal funds in fiscal 1972, less Administrative expenses, for their annual highway safety programs.

Pending enactment of the 1972 Department of Transportation Appropriation Act, the Congress has enacted a continuing resolution for Fiscal Year 1972 which limits obligations to the Fiscal Year 1971 level of \$75 million.

The Department said further adjustment in the funds to be obligated to the States will depend upon final action on the President's 1972 budget.

The funds are available to the 50 States, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico on a 50-50 matching basis. They are to be used to implement the 16 Highway Safety Standards administered cooperatively by the Safety Administration, the Highway Administration, and the States.

The Standards cover programs involving periodic motor vehicle inspection, motor vehicle registration, motorcycle safety, driver education, driver licensing, codes and laws, traffic courts, alcohol in relation to highway safety, traffic control devices, emergency medical service, identification and surveillance of accident locations, police traffic services, pedestrian safety, traffic records, highway design, construction, and maintenance, and debris hazard control and cleanup.

The Department of Transportation announced the construction and delivery of 50 periscopes which will be installed and tested on a number of Government-owned motor vehicles. The three mirror system was developed for the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration by Donnely Mirrors, Inc., of Holland, Michigan under a \$14,000 contract. It is in compliance with a proposed motor vehicle safety standard that would require indirect visibility systems for motor vehicles. These systems would allow drivers to monitor the motoring environment to the rear of the vehicle.

Specifically, the system which is installed on the roof of the car, gives a clear field of view to drivers of all heights. It provides a daylight transmission level of at least 50%, and also provides for glare protection by reducing the transmission to 8%.

Donnely Mirrors has delivered the first five of these systems in Detroit where they were installed and tested in 1970 Ford Falcons, owned and operated by the General Services Administration. Similar tests are planned in the near future in Los Angeles, Seattle, Denver, Kansas City, Duluth, Washington, D.C., Boston, Phoenix, and at Cape Kennedy, Florida.

Six additional State Alcohol Safety Action Project (ASAP) locations, making a current total of 35 in a national countermeasures program designed to curb drunk-drivers, were announced today by Secretary of Transportation John A. Volpe.

The new sites include: statewide efforts by the States of Delaware and Idaho; Los Angeles County, California; the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico; Sioux City, Iowa; and in Utah, Salt Lake City and county, and four additional counties, Box Elder, Davis, Utah and Weber.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration budget for fiscal year 1972 allots an additional \$5-million for countermeasures designed to curtail alcohol-related deaths and injuries on the Nation's highways. This underscores the intention of his Department, Secretary Volpe said, "to control the problem drinker and to keep him from driving."

Citing the fact that at least half of our annual highway fatalities are caused by the excessive consumption of alcohol, Volpe noted that total commitments "to check the menace of those who drive while intoxicated" are approximately \$82-million for three and-a-half years, while the 100 percent Federally funded contracts are in force.

"The scope and cost of this national program should put all on notice that we mean business in our effort to control drivers who wantonly risk their own lives and the lives of others by driving while drunk," Volpe said. "The drinking driver is a threat to all in his path. He is racking up a shameful record of fatalities on our highways. We intend to stop him."

The newly nominated Project sites now have the opportunity to develop proposals in keeping with the aims of the Traffic Safety Administration's Alcohol Countermeasures Program. If their proposals are approved, the six locations will share in total Federal funding of approximately \$20-million during the term of the contracts.

Funds allocated to ASAP Projects support a wide variety of activities to identify drunk drivers; make decisions concerning control of their driving.

Projects announced previously are the States of New Hampshire and South Dakota; Phoenix, Arizona; Columbus, Georgia; Indianapolis, Indiana; Wichita, Kansas; New Orleans, Louisiana; Baltimore, Maryland; Boston, Massachusetts; Kansas City, Missouri; Lincoln, Nebraska; Cincinnati, Ohio; Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; San Antonio, Texas; Richland County, South Carolina; Hennepin County, Minnesota; Cumberland and York Counties, Maine; Fairfax County, Virginia; Pulaski County, Arkansas, and Hillsborough County, Florida.

ASAP Projects are already underway in Denver, Colorado; Washtenaw County, Michigan; Albuquerque, New Mexico; Nassau County, New York; Mecklenburg County, North Carolina (City of Charlotte); Portland and Eugene, Oregon; the State of Vermont; Seattle, Washington (King County); and Marathon and Sheboygan Counties, Wisconsin.

The Department of Justice and the Department of Transportation today urged the individual States to work closely with the Federal agencies responsible for highway safety and general law enforcement. In a letter dated August 24, 1971, addressed to the Governors of each State, and signed jointly by Attorney General John Mitchell and Secretary of Transportation John A. Volpe, the Cabinet members stressed the importance of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act and the National Highway Safety Act, and asked that full coordination between Federal, State and local agencies be achieved in all areas covered by these acts.

Specifically, State Planning Agencies established under the Omnibus Crime Control program, and the Governor's Representative responsible for highway safety programs under the Highway Safety Act are encouraged to work closely together.

In order to achieve this goal, a number of actions are recommended:

1. A designee of the Governor's Representative should be included on the State Planning Agency supervisory board, as well as on local or regional planning councils established under the Omnibus Crime Control program.
2. State Planning Agencies should consult with highway safety agencies when planning technical assistance programs related to highway safety.
3. State Planning Agencies and their local or regional planning councils should consider the effect of highway safety programs in developing their comprehensive State plan.
4. Representatives of State Planning Agencies and local or regional councils should meet with the Governor's Representative to formulate highway safety plans within the State dealing with police traffic services and enforcement.
5. In preparing the police traffic services and enforcement components of highway safety plans, the Governor's Representative should consider the law enforcement programs in the State Agency's comprehensive plan.
6. The Governor's Representative and the State Planning Agency should consider use of National Highway Safety funds and Omnibus Crime Control funds for grants which could be funded jointly under the two programs.
7. Formal channels should be established to disseminate information between the two programs.

Both Attorney General Mitchell and Secretary Volpe expressed the hope that, through strengthened coordination efforts, State and local programs can be carried out even more effectively in these important areas.
