FOR MERITORIOUS SERVICE

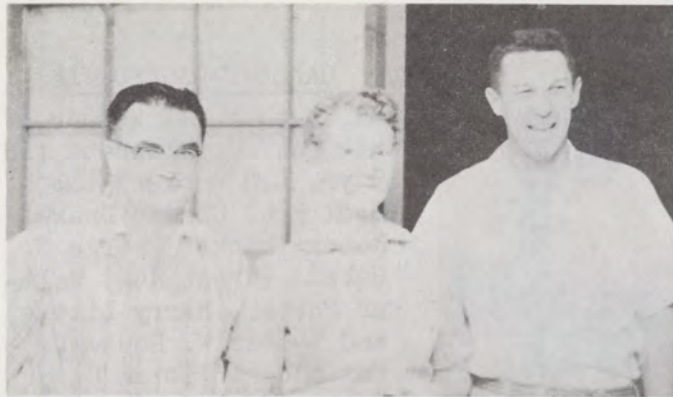
