Southern California Terminal Radar Approach Control

- Will provide radar air traffic control services to aircraft in controlled airspace from the San Fernando Valley to the Mexican Border.
- Consolidates Burbank, Coast (El Toro), Los Angeles, Ontario and San Diego TRACONs into one facility in San Diego.
- 95 controller workstations
- 115,000 square feet
- 500 FAA employees, including air traffic controllers, maintenance technicians, administrative personnel, trainers and management
- Cost - \$139,100,000
